## ORDER UNDER SECTION 8(f) OF THE INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT OF 1940 DECLARING THAT APPLICANT HAS CEASED TO BE AN INVESTMENT COMPANY

COVA Variable Annuity Account Four (the "Applicant") filed an application on May 30, 2008, requesting an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 (the "Act") declaring that it had ceased to be an investment company.

On June 27, 2008, a notice of filing of the application was issued (Investment Company Act Release No. 28322). The notice gave interested persons an opportunity to request a hearing and stated that an order disposing of the application would be issued unless a hearing was ordered. No request for a hearing was filed, and the Commission did not order a hearing.

The matter having been considered, it is found, on the basis of the information set forth in the application, that Applicant has ceased to be an investment company.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, under Section 8(f) of the Act, that COVA Variable Annuity Account Four's registration under the Act shall immediately cease to be in effect.
