This reopening of the Title V permit addresses permit deficiencies identified by EPA on October 8, 2004 and EPA's order of March 15, 2005. The reopening also incorporates changes in applicable requirements authorized in an Authority to Construct and addresses issues raised by refinery appeals and comments.

The District sent formal notices of reopening pursuant to BAAQMD Regulation 2-6-415 on December 16, 2004 and May 12, 2005. The regulation requires at least 30 days' notice for any reopening.

Public notices were published on April 21, 2005 and August 9, 2005. The public notice period for Application 12429 ended on May 24, 2005; the public notice period for Application 12602 ended on September 8, 2005. Comments were received by the facility and EPA.

This is a submittal of a proposed permit to EPA for review. Attached are the draft responses to EPA comments of September 8, 2005. This document includes responses to comments made about four refineries. All of the comments do not apply to Chevron. The responses to the refinery comments will be prepared within two months.
