This reopening of the Title V permit addressed administrative amendments, minor revisions, and significant revisions in the Title V permit due to several NSR applications. The Significant revisions are included in application numbers 10158 and 13476, which will affect Table II.A.1, II.A.3, IV.C.3.1, IV.F.1.13, VII.C.3.1, VII.F.1.13, and Section VI (Condition numbers 22979 and 22641) of the Title V permit. Per Regulation 2, Rule 6-412, the public comments were only applicable to the significant revisions as identified above.

The public notice period for application 13024 ended on March 27, 2007. Comments were received from the applicant. Some additional administrative amendments were made as a result of those comments.
