The purpose of the significant revision is to propose an alternative monitoring plan for H2S monitoring at the thermal oxidizer for the marine loading terminal. The effect of the minor revisions is an emissions increase of 4.6 ton POC/yr.

All changes are clearly shown in "strikeout/underline format" and have been addressed in the permit evaluation/statement of basis. The District invites comments on these changes. Comments made on other aspects of the permit will be accepted but may not be addressed at this time. All comments must be received by December 27, 2006. Prior to this closing date, the public may also request a public hearing for this revision of the permit.

Significant revisions of Major Facility Review Permits are also subject to review and approval by US EPA. If US EPA has not objected to a proposed permit and the District has not addressed a public comment in a satisfactory manner, the public may petition US EPA, Region IX, Operating Permits Section at 75 Hawthorne Street, San Francisco, CA 94105, within 60 days after the end of US EPA's review, to reconsider the decision to not object to the permit.
