The purpose of this action is to incorporate the refinery NESHAPS (MACT), 40 CFR 63, Subpart UUU, for the reformers and the sulfur recovery units; to add requirements in the EPA's consent decree for the sulfur recovery units and sulfur pits; and to incorporate some minor permit changes from Application 13424. These revisions will not have any impact on emissions.

All changes are clearly shown in "strikeout/underline format" and have been addressed in the permit evaluation/statement of basis. The District invites comments on these changes. All comments must be received by March 15, 2008. Prior to this closing date, the public may also request a public hearing for this revision of the permit.

Significant revisions of Major Facility Review Permits are also subject to review and approval by US EPA. If US EPA has not objected to a proposed permit and the District has not addressed a public comment in a satisfactory manner, the public may petition US EPA, Region IX, Operating Permits Section at 75 Hawthorne Street, San Francisco, CA 94105, within 60 days after the end of US EPA's review, to reconsider the decision to not object to the permit.
