Jack P. Broadbent EXECUTIVE OFFICER/APCO This is to advise you that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is proposing a minor revision to the Major Facility Review Permit for Owens-Brockway Glass Container, Inc., Facility Number A0030, and is submitting the permit to EPA for review.

The purpose of the minor permit revision is to change permit conditions for Sources S-25, S-27, S-29, S-30, S-32 and S-33 Hot End Surface Treatment (HEST) to allow a change in coating from stannic chloride to monobutyltin trichloride (MBTT). The coating is applied to the surface of glass containers to make them scratch resistant. Secondly, Owens Brockway Glass Company is proposing to modify Source S-10, Furnace C, to add a forming line. The new forming line will replace the C-1 forming line that was taken out of service in 2000. The new forming line will be entirely new, and installed in the same location as C-1, but will not increase the capacity of the furnace since it is an "identical" replacement. New sources S-135 C-1a Forming Line and S-136 HEST will replace S-75 C-1 Forming Line and S-24 and 31 HEST. These actions are expected to result in an emission increase of approximately 2.1 tons of POC per year and 1.2 tons of  $PM_{10}$  per year.

Also, the permit dates in Section I.B.1 have been corrected to reflect the March 21, 2006 renewal of the Title V Permit.

The proposed minor revision will be effective immediately. The permit will be formally re-issued after EPA review. This revision is not subject to public comment and therefore, requires no public notice.
