The District has made some changes in response to the comments received. These changes are discussed the District's response to comments, the attachment to this letter.

In addition to these changes, the District has also removed two 112(j) citations since the MACTs were promulgated. For the Organic Liquids Distribution MACT, Subpart EEEE, the 112(j) requirements were removed from Section IV, the Custom Schedule of Compliance, and Condition 21063, and replaced with Subpart EEEE as a future effective requirement in the facility table, Table IV-A. Likewise, the 112(j) requirements for the Boiler and Process Heater MACT, Subpart DDDD, were removed from Section IV and the MACT added as a future effective requirement for sources, S-444 and S-460. The District has also made typographical corrections.

All changes have been listed in the new Revision History, Section X of the permit.

The District has decided to issue the Major Facility Review Permit. Enclosed for your information are copies of the final permit and the transmittal letter to the facility including the response to comments.
