On behalf of my client, Acme Fiberglass, Inc. I am attaching an application for emission reduction credit on behalf of Acme Fiberglass, Inc. (Facility #A0575). Due to the loss of important contracts the owner has decided to shut down the business. Operations continued through September, 2004 and on October 28, 2004 all equipment and supplies were sold at auction. The operations have shut down permanently and will not be relocated. The emission reductions are based on the 3-year operations history of units 1, 2 and 3 commencing September 2001 through September 2004. Unit #4 was an inactive resin storage tank and does not result in emission reductions. The emissions were calculated from operating logs and emission reports submitted to the District. The basis of emission calculations are purchase records and plastic composite emission factors as published in Subpart WWWW to 40 CFR Part 63.

It is the intention of Acme Fiberglass, Inc. to surrender the operating permits, including the recently issued Major Facility Review Permit A0575. The facility owner should be invoiced for the any fees related to this application.
