The District issued UTC a Title V permit on October 3, 2003. Due to closure of many sources, including mixers, paint booths, sandblasters, solid and liquid propellant test stands, UTC is no longer a major source of criteria or hazardous air pollutants, and is no longer classified as an aerospace manufacturing facility. In light of the above, UTC requested the District in a letter dated December 22, 2004, to cancel all their existing permits, except for 26 minor sources. An estimate of NOx and CO emissions, the highest combustion contaminants, from the 26 minor sources, is 31 TPY and 7 TPY, respectively, which is less than 100 tons per year. Please refer to Attachment A. UTC's letter also requested the District to cancel their Title V permit, because the potential to emit from the 26 minor sources that will remain at the facility, is below the Major Source thresholds. The letter is attached.

Since the facility's potential to emit is obviously below the Major Source thresholds, the District is canceling the existing Title V Permit.

The cancellation is effective as of the date of this letter.

The District will also notify the California Air Resources Board and the facility in writing that the permit has been cancelled.
