No comments were received from the public, EPA, or ARB.

After the public comment ended, the District corrected, in response to a request from the City of Sunnyvale, the capacities of the wastewater treatment equipment (S-110, S-120, S-130, S-140, S-150, S-161, and S-170) from 19.5 million to 29.5 million gallons of wastewater per day as stated in Table II-A of the Final Major Facility Review Permit. The correction of the wastewater capacities was based on the facility's permitted average dry weather flow capacity of 29.5 million gallons of wastewater per day stipulated in the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit No.CA0037621 issued by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board to the City of Sunnyvale on December 28, 1988.
