SAN FRANCISCO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (SITE #A1784)

Background

This review was initiated as part of the District evaluation of an application by San Francisco International Airport for a Title V Permit. It is standard practice of the Compliance and Enforcement Division to undertake a compliance record to review in advance of a Permit to Operate. The purpose of this review is to assure that any non-compliance problems identified during the prior permit term or twelve months have been adequately addressed. Additionally, the review is intended to recommend such additional permit conditions and limitations as may be necessary to reasonably assure on going compliance.

Finding

The Enforcement Division staff has commenced a review of the records for the San Francisco International Airport for the period of November 25, 2002 to November 25, 2003. During this review period, San Francisco International Airport's activities known to the District include:

No Notice of Violations (NOV) have been issued to this facility.

No complaints were received.

No breakdowns, inoperative monitors, or excesses have occurred.

This facility is currently not under a variance or an abatement order.

Conclusions

The Compliance and Enforcement Division finds that ongoing compliance can be reasonably assured for this facility, due to the above record.
