Dear Ms. Jordan:

This is to advise you that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is proposing a minor revision to the Major Facility Review Permit for Waste Management of Alameda County, Facility Number A2066, and is submitting the permit to EPA for review.

The purpose of this minor permit revision is to modify permit conditions for several sources. Application # 2653 increases the gasoline throughput limit at the S-99 Non-Retail Gasoline Dispensing Facility and results in 0.017 tons/year of POC emission increases. Applications # 7363 and # 10004 modify the landfill gas collection system description for the S-2 Altamont Landfill and do not result in any emission increases. Applications # 10514 and 10515 modify the wastewater throughput limit and VOC concentration limits for the S-140 and S-141 Aerated Biological Reactors. Application # 10515 results in 0.253 tons/year of POC emission increases and 0.059 tons/year of NPOC emission increases. Total emission increases for all applications are 0.270 tons/year of POC and 0.059 tons/year of NPOC. Waste Management provided 0.405 tons/year of POC emission reduction credits to reimburse the District for offsets that were previously provided by the District from the Small Facility Banking Account and 0.311 tons/year of POC emission reduction credits to offset the POC emission increases from these applications.

This revision is minor pursuant to BAAQMD Regulation 2-6-215 and will be effective immediately. The permit will be formally re-issued after EPA review. This revision is not subject to public comment and therefore, requires no public notice.

A copy of the proposed revisions to the Major Facility Review Permit and the engineering evaluations for Application # 2653, Applications # 7363 and # 10004, and Applications # 10514 and # 10515 are enclosed for your review. This letter and the engineering evaluations constitute the statement of basis for this minor permit revision.
