The District proposed a minor permit revision for this facility on May 17, 2007. The main purpose of this minor revision was to modify permit conditions for the S-140 and S-141 Aerated Biological Reactors, which are part of the wastewater treatment system for the Altamont Landfill. These condition revisions allow Waste Management to demonstrate compliance with POC emission limits in lieu of meeting wastewater throughput and VOC concentration limits. The proposed conditions retain the current wastewater testing frequency and record keeping requirements and add a POC emission calculation procedure. The proposed revisions did not result in any emission increases.

The EPA comment period ended on July 1, 2007. No comments on this proposed minor were received from EPA or the facility.

The District has decided to issue the revised permit incorporating the proposed minor revision. The final revised permit can be viewed on the BAAQMD website at http://www.baaqmd.gov/pmt/title\_v/public\_notices.htm.
