The District proposed a minor permit revision for this facility on April 1, 2004. The main purpose of this revision was to add a new source: S-14 Diesel Engine for Emergency Standby Generator. This revision resulted in the following emission increases: 0.200 tons/year of NO_x, 0.017 tons/year of CO, 0.009 tons/year of SO₂, 0.008 tons/year of POC, and 0.002 tons/year of PM_{10} . NOx and POC emission increases were fully offset from the District's Small Facility Banking Account. The following changes were included in the proposed permit.

- Add S-14 to Table II-A in Section II
- Add Table IV-D for S-14 in Section IV
- Add Condition # 21195 for S-14 in Section VI
- Add Table VII-D for S-14 in Section VII
- Delete future effective dates that have passed from Tables IV-A, IV-C, VII-A, and VII-C
- Update Revision History in Section X

No comments on this proposed minor revision were received from EPA or the facility. The District has made the following additional administrative revisions to the proposed permit. The detail is in Appendix A to this letter.

- Update standard text in Section I.B.1 and Section III
- Switch the order of Sections IX and X for consistency with other MFR permits

ATTACHMENT 1

Administrative Amendments to MFR Permit for A2740

May 2004

I. Standard Conditions

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- B. Conditions to Implement Regulation 2, Rule 6, Major Facility Review
 - 1. This Major Facility Review Permit was issued on July 28, 2003 and expires on June 30, 2008. The permit holder shall submit a complete application for renewal of this Major Facility Review Permit no later than December 31, 2007 and no earlier than June 30, 2007. If a complete application for renewal has not been submitted in accordance with this deadline, the facility may not operate after June 30, 2008. If the permit renewal has not been issued by June 30, 2008, but a complete application for renewal has been submitted in accordance with the above deadlines, the existing permit will continue in force until the District takes final action on the renewal application. (Regulation 2-6-307, 404.2, 407 & 409.6; MOP Volume II, Part 3, §4.2)

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III. Generally Applicable Requirements

The permit holder shall comply with all applicable requirements, including those specified in the BAAQMD and SIP rules and regulations and other federal requirements cited below. These requirements apply in a general manner to the facility and/or to sources exempt from the requirement to obtain a District Permit to Operate. The District has determined that these requirements will not be violated under normal, routine operations, and that no additional periodic monitoring or reporting to demonstrate compliance is warranted. In cases where a requirement, in addition to being generally applicable, is also specifically applicable to one or more sources, the requirement and the source are also included in Section IV, Source-Specific Applicable Requirements, of this permit. This section also contains provisions that may apply to temporary sources.
