This is to advise you that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is proposing a Significant Revision of the Major Facility Review (MFR) Permit for Facility # A4618. The District is also proposing a Significant Revision of this permit.

The main purpose of the proposed significant revision (Application # 13196) is to establish an alternative wellhead oxygen standard for landfill gas collection wells associated with the S-1 Keller Canyon Landfill. District Regulation 8, Rule 34 and the NSPS for MSW Landfills allow the District to establish sitespecific wellhead limits in lieu of the default wellhead limits stated in the regulations, provided the site-specific alternative wellhead limits do not result in subsurface fires or inhibit anaerobic decomposition of the refuse. District has determined that a proposed alternative oxygen standard of 15% O₂ by volume is appropriate for five gas collection wells, as long as this alternative limit does not result in surface emission leaks near the vicinity of these wells. The District is proposing to identify the alternative wellhead oxygen limit, the applicability criteria, the monitoring and record keeping requirements, and other procedures related to the alternative oxygen standard in Condition # 17309, Part 20c and in Tables IV-A, VII-A, and VIII. The District is also proposing to make an administrative correction to a date citation in Section X Revision History of the MFR Permit. This application will not result in any emission increases.

The statement of basis for Application # 13196 contains a detailed explanation of all proposed permit revisions. All proposed permit revisions are clearly shown in strikeout and underline formatting in the proposed permit and are summarized in Section X of the proposed permit.

The District has made a preliminary decision to issue the Significant Revision to the Major Facility Review Permit, but the final decision on the permit issuance will consider public and EPA comments on this preliminary decision. The notice inviting written public comments will be published in the Contra Costa Times. The final date for comments is August 15, 2006.
