The purpose of the reopening is to add monitoring to demonstrate compliance with thermal oxidizer destruction efficiency requirements. The proposed permit changes have no effect on emissions.

The District sent the formal notice of reopening pursuant to BAAQMD Regulation 2-6-415 on February 1, 2005. The District invited public comment on the proposed changes to the permit. The notice was published in the Contra Costa Times on February 9, 2004. The final date for comments was March 15, 2005. The District received no comments. The District has decided to issue the permit.

In addition, the requirement for EPA review of the proposed minor revision of the permit that was processed under Application 11265 has been completed.

The purpose of the minor revision was to modify the permit conditions for storage tank S-323 Tank A-323 abated by A-14 Vapor Recovery System to allow the storage of alkylate gasoline blending material.

The District sent the formal notice of the minor revision to the EPA and ARB on December 30, 2004. The District received no comments. The District has decided to issue the permit.
