NOTICE INVITING WRITTEN PUBLIC COMMENTS

NOTICE is hereby given that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is proposing to revise the Major Facility Review Permit for the following Facility:

The purpose of the revision is to incorporate conditions from 14 District Authorities to Construct/Permits to Operate that were not included in the most recent Major Facility Review Permit issued on March 9, 2007. The District invites comments on whether the significant revisions correctly incorporate the underlying District permit conditions. Comments made on other issues will be accepted but may not be addressed at this time. All comments must be received by February 8, 2008. The District will also consider requests to hold a public hearing on the proposed significant revisions until this date, and may hold such a hearing upon a showing of good cause.

The proposed revised permit will be simultaneously sent to US EPA for their 45-day review period. The public may petition US EPA, Region IX, Operating Permits Section at 75 Hawthorne Street, San Francisco, CA 94105 to object to the permit within 60 days after the end of US EPA's review. All changes to the permit are clearly show in "strikeout/underline" format in the proposed permit and have been explained in the statement of basis, and the statement of basis identifies the Authorities to Construct/Permits to Operate that involve significant revisions upon which the public is invited to comment.
