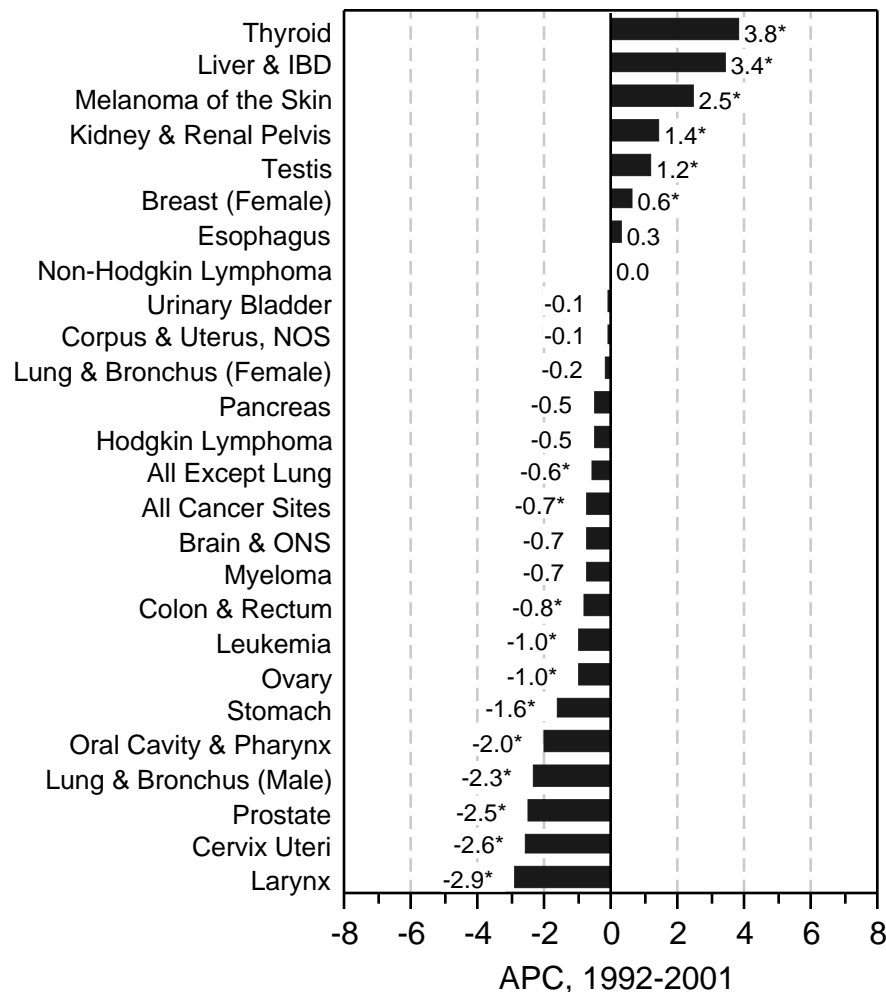

Trends in US Cancer Death Rates

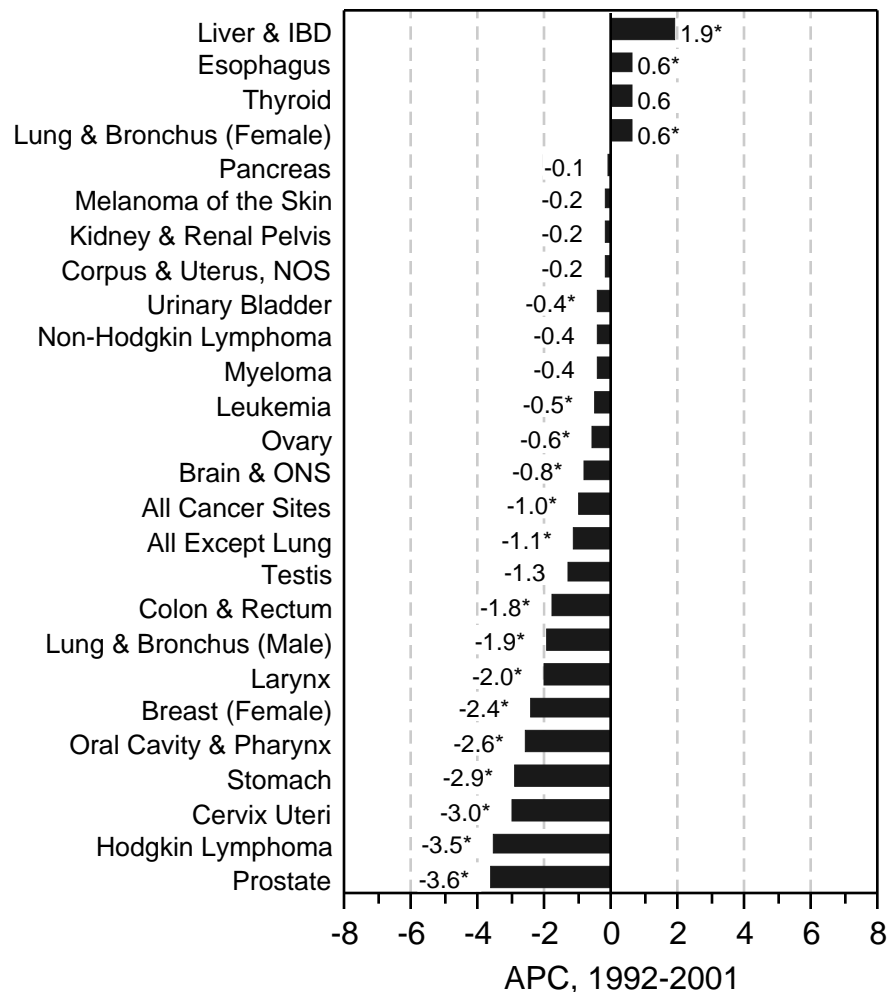

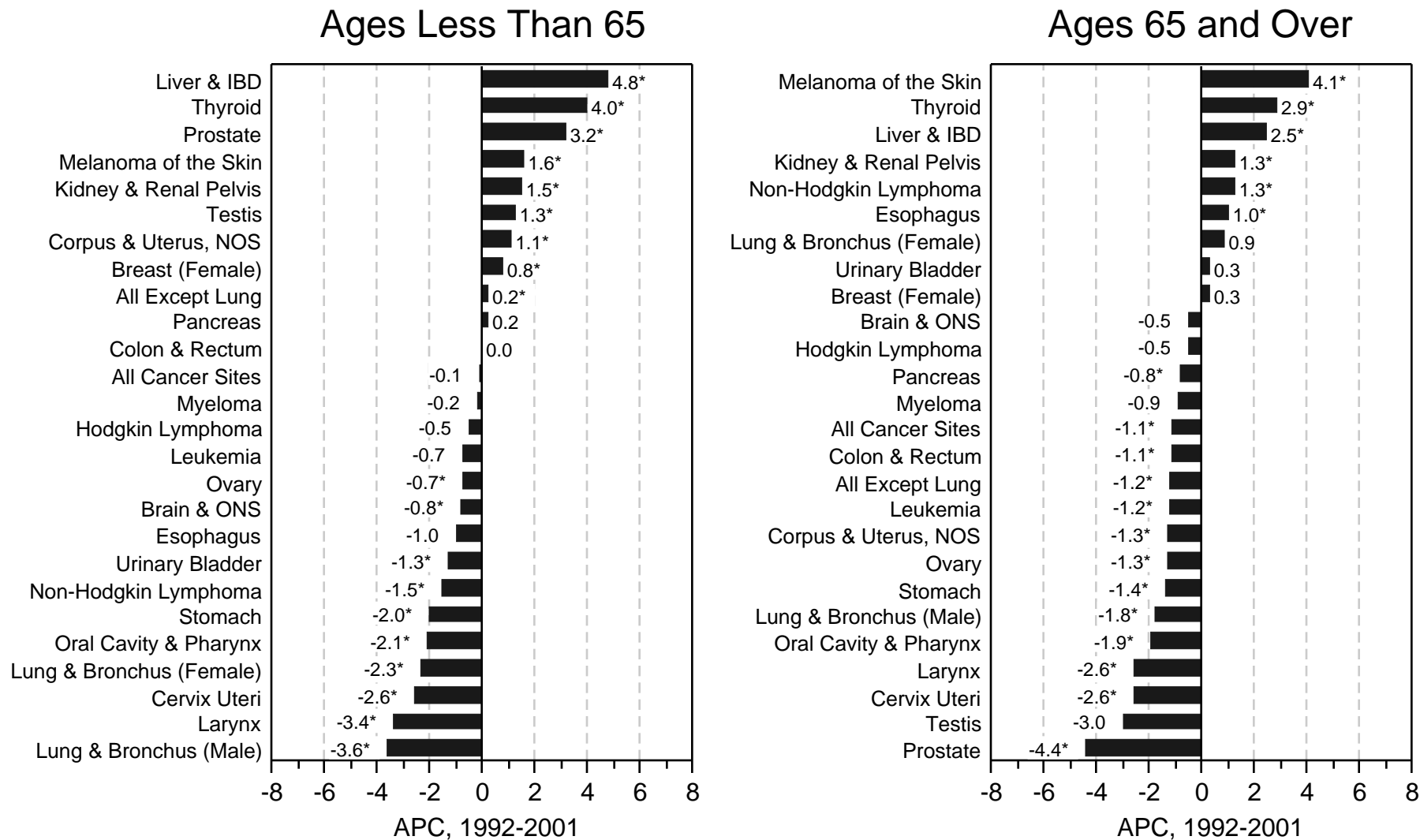

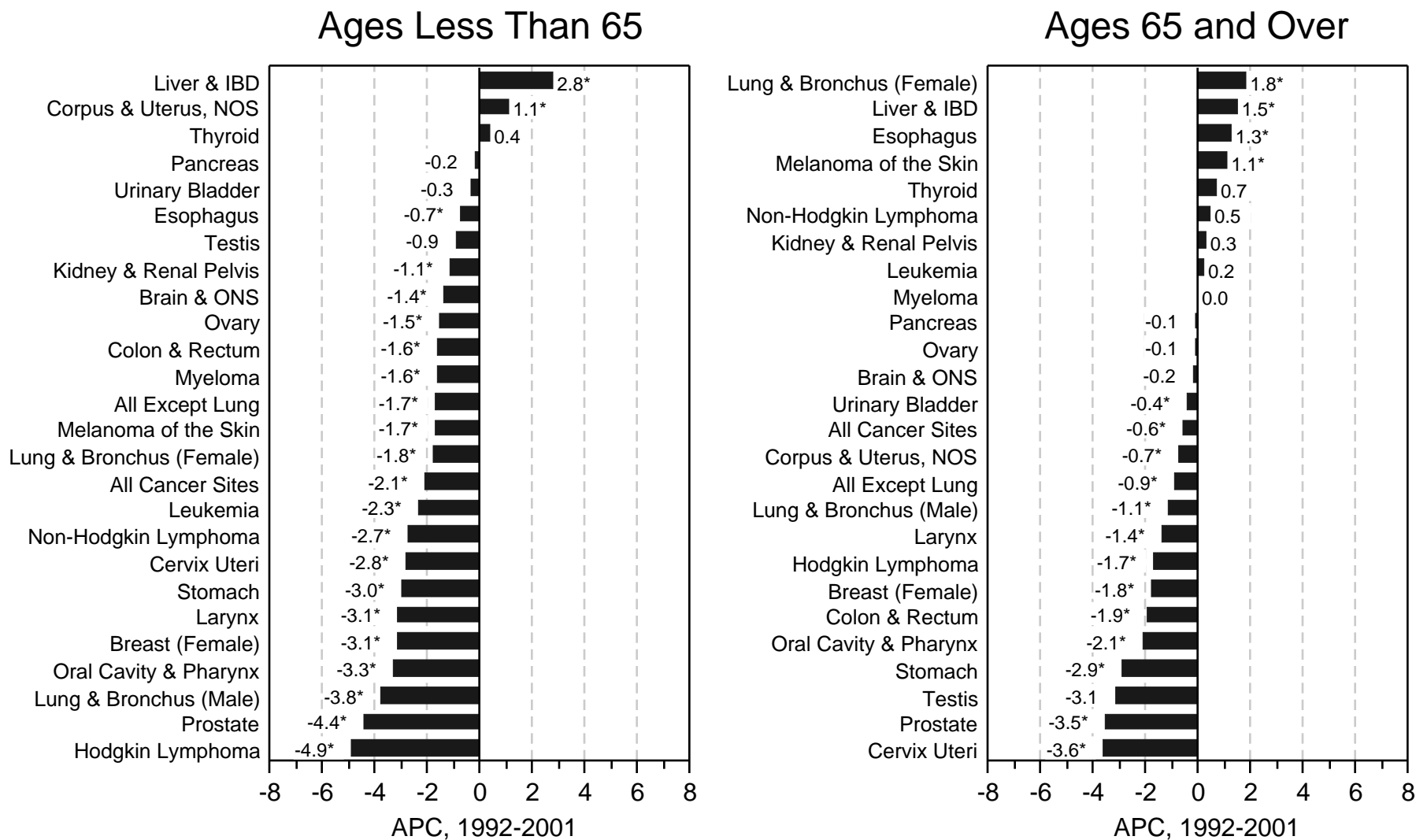

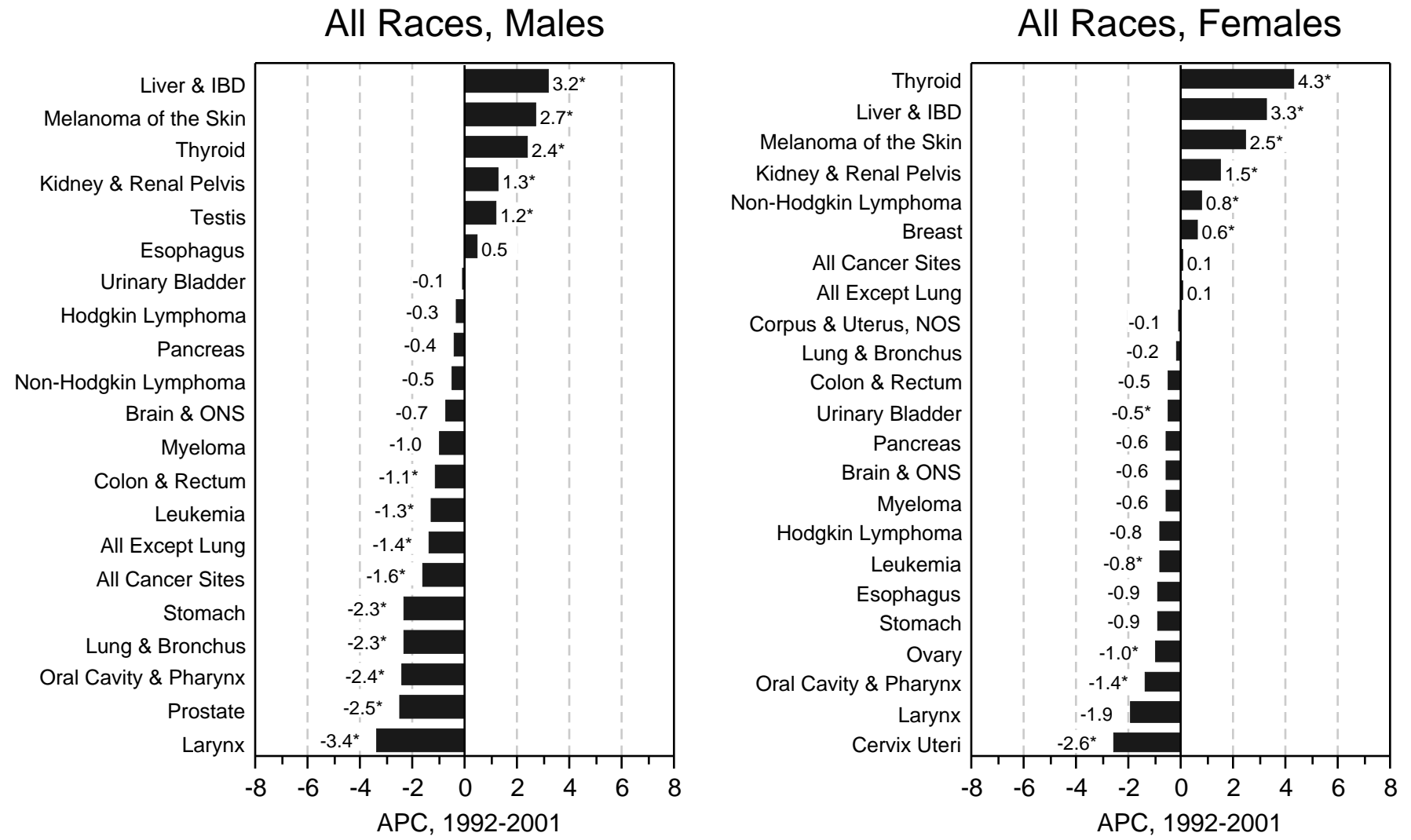

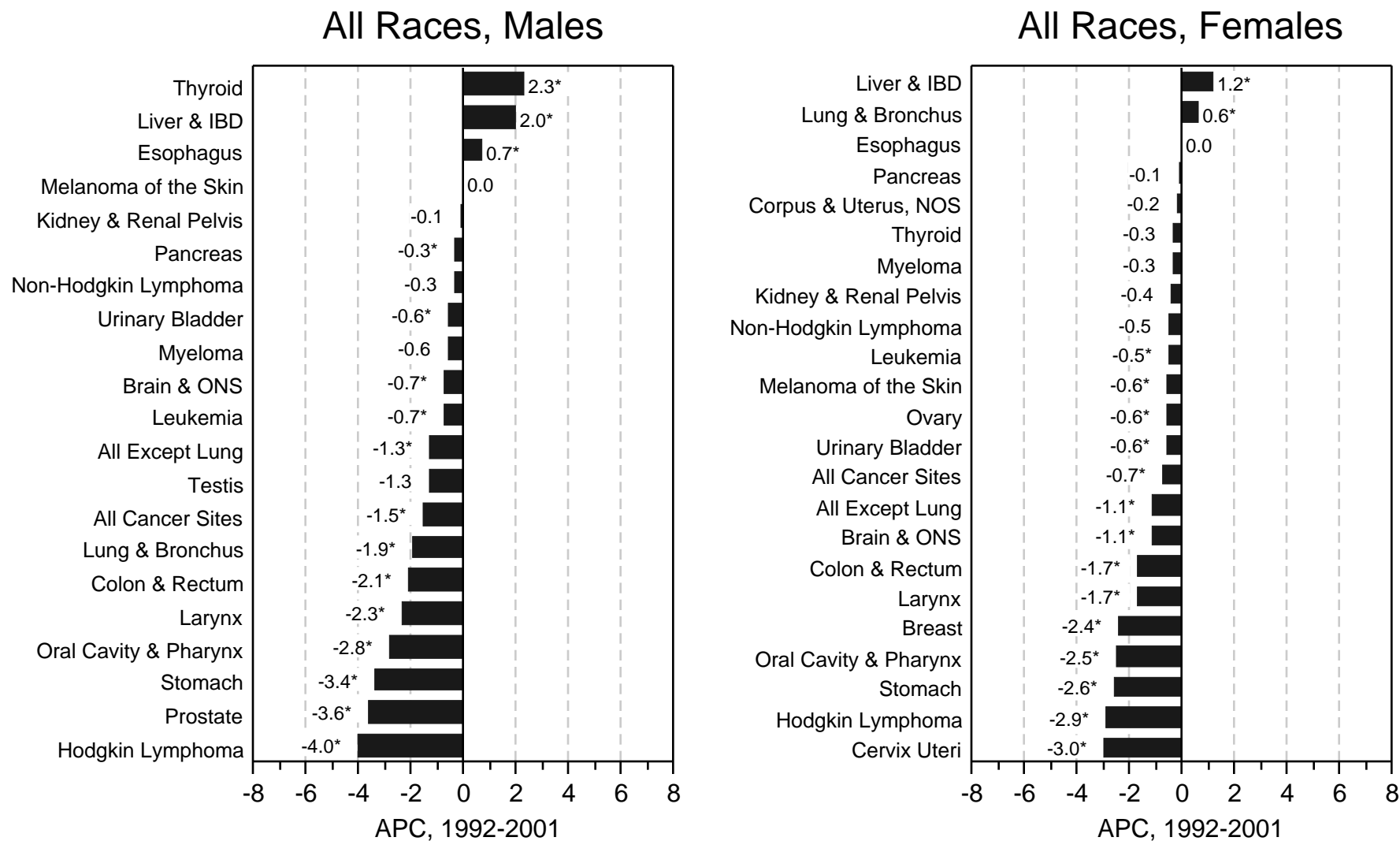
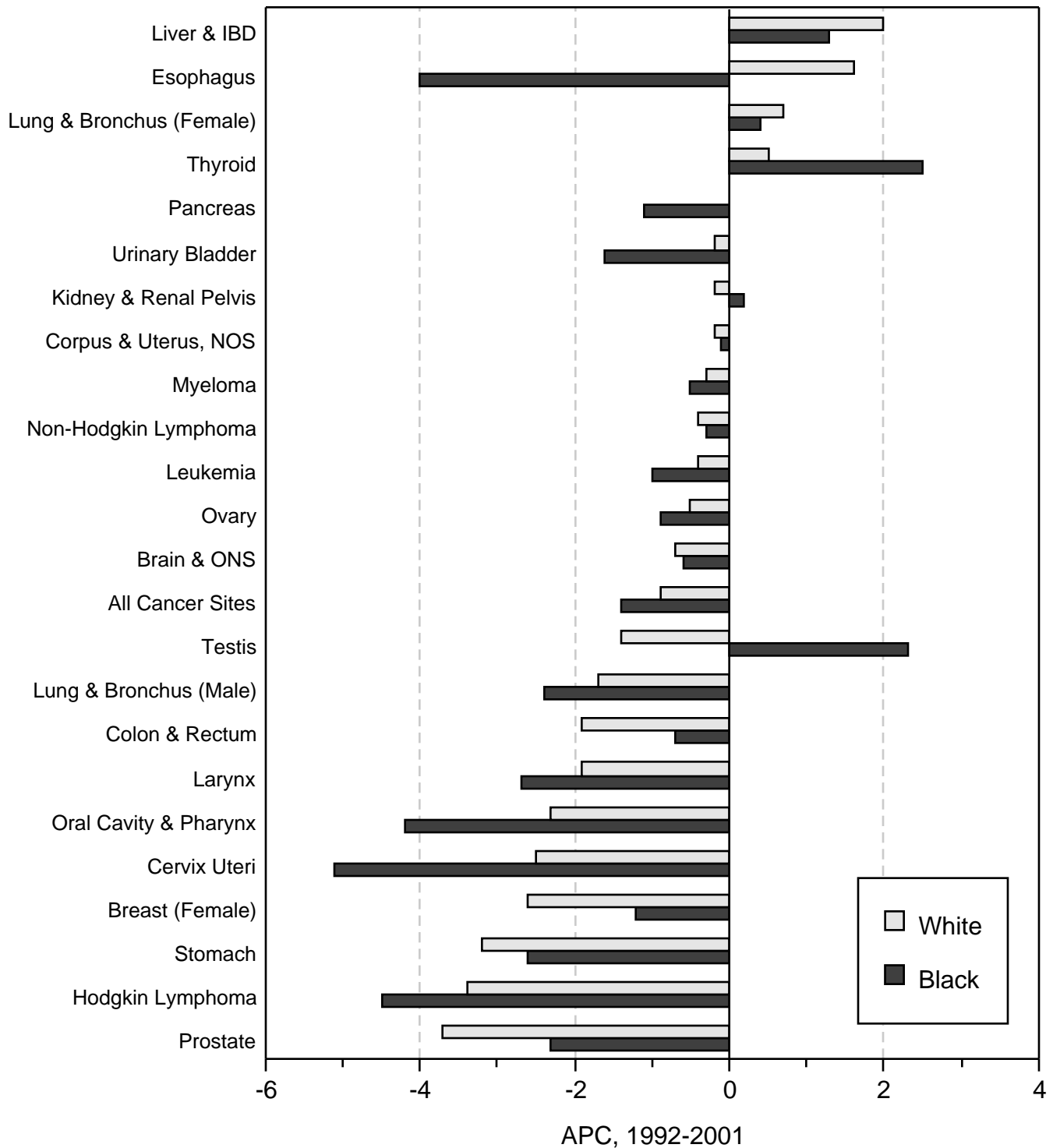

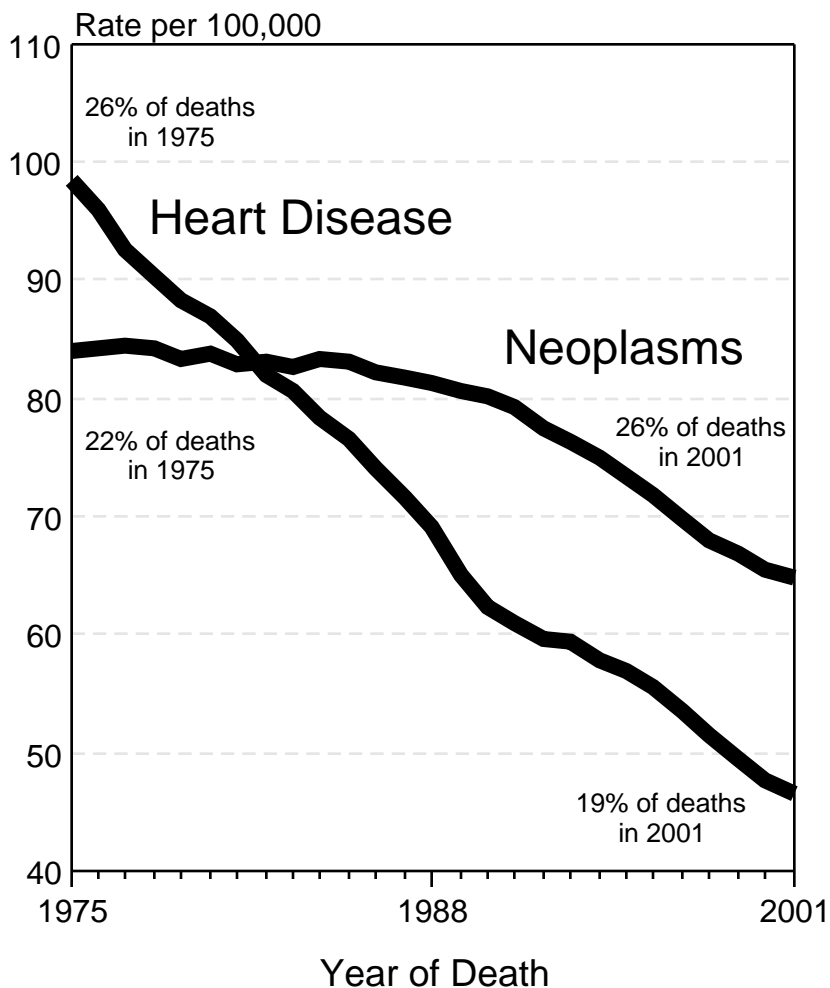
Trends in US Death Rates, 1992-2001 by Primary Cancer Site All Ages, by Race

Ages 65 and Over

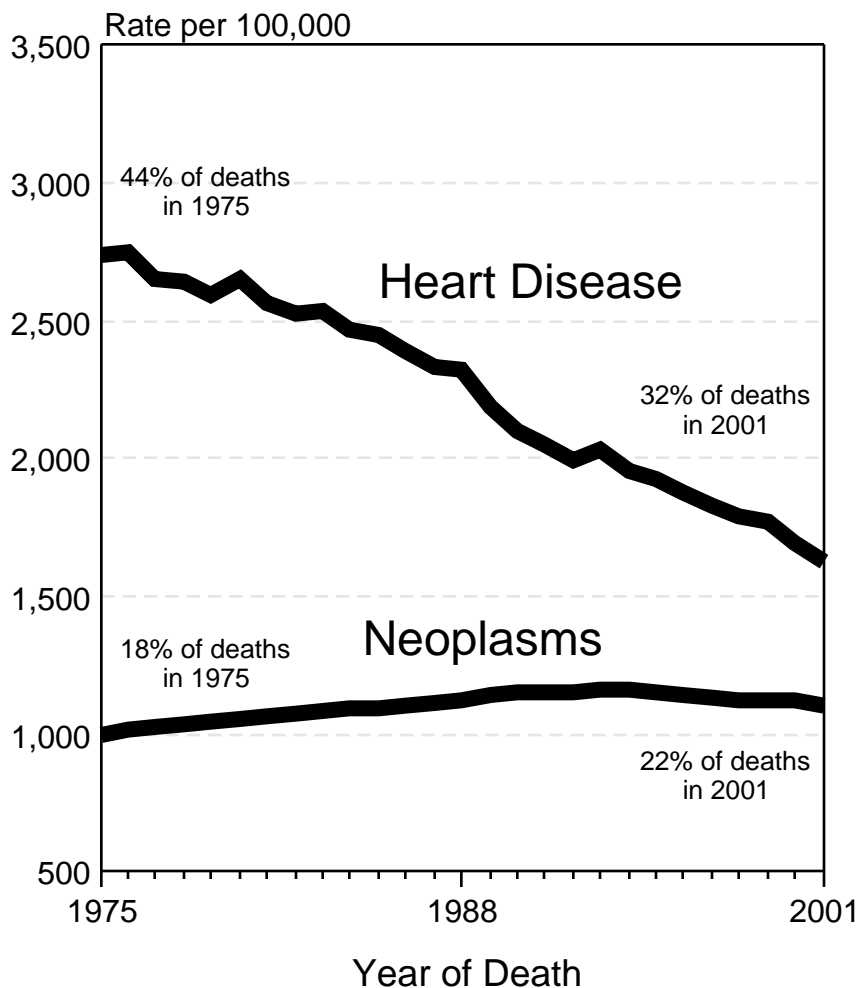
