- (a) A signed original and four copies of a petition for any extraordinary writ are required to be filed, although this court may request additional copies.
- (b) For amount of fee to be paid to this court see 6 Cir. I.O.P. 103. The proceeding will be dismissed if the fee is not paid.
- (c) A petition for any extraordinary writ shall be filed in paper format with the clerk's office. All documents in the proceeding filed after the petition shall be field electronically, in accordance with 6 Cir. R. 25 and this court's Guide to Electronic Filing, unless otherwise ordered by the court.
