



UPCOMING CARL MOYER PROGRAM APPLICATION WORKSHOPS

Find out more about how you can get a grant to reduce exhaust emissions from your heavy-duty engines! All workshops are FREE!

The Bay Area Air Quality Management District (Air District) offers money for projects to:

- replace old diesel engines with new, cleaner, engines in existing equipment,
- retrofit existing diesel engines with emission control devices,
- purchase new vehicles or equipment with emissions below current state and federal standards.

Who Should Attend

Anyone that owns and operates heavy-duty engine equipment in the Bay Area may apply for the Air District's Carl Moyer Program grants. Commercial operators and public agencies are eligible to apply. In previous funding cycles, grants have been awarded for projects to reduce emissions from marine vessels (including tugboats, ferries, and fishing boats), on-road heavy-duty trucks, transit buses, construction equipment, locomotives, and agricultural pumps.
