# **Dayton Homecoming, 1909**

Celebrations honoring the Wrights were held in Dayton, May 13 and June 17-18, 1909.

Scenes on May 13, when thousands greeted Wilbur, Orville, and Katharine in Dayton on their return from European trip, including views of crowds, Dayton Union Station scenes, and photograph of Wrights in carriage drawn by four white horses in which they were driven to their home.
