I. BACKGROUND

1. At its 18th Session, the Review Sub-Committee continued its review of the Harmonized System on the basis of trade statistics and agreed to :
 - (1) retain the headings and the subheadings listed in Doc. 42.233, Annex III and also those listed in Annexes I and II if two or more requests to retain them had been submitted;
 - (2) re-examine the other codes in Annexes I and II at its next session on the basis of a new document in which the Secretariat would make proposals for retention or deletion.

II SECRETARIAT COMMENTS

2. On 18 October 1998 the Secretariat received a Note from the Administration of Norway stating that it was no longer interested in retaining subheadings 3702.92 (Annex I to Doc. 42.233), 4411.31 (Annex II to Doc. 42.233), 2911.00, 3805.10 and 90, 4405.00 and 7505.11 (Annex III to the same document).
3. It is recalled that the various principles adopted by the Sub-Committee and endorsed by the Committee at previous sessions are set out in paragraphs 2 and 3 of Doc. 42.233 (RSC/18). In addition, the trade statistics (import figures) for the reference years (1993 to 1995) and for 1996 (analysis of trade trends) are set out in Doc. 41.817, Annex I (RSC/17).
4. Taking into account these points and the instructions which were received from the Sub-Committee, the Secretariat has prepared the present document which has four annexes.

ANNEX I

5. This Annex covers the heading (No. 25.27) and 55 subheadings that the Secretariat suggests deleting. The Annex also indicates the Contracting Parties that have requested retention (with reason given, if any) and the Secretariat's comments.
6. As regards the requests for retention, three Contracting Parties are mentioned in this Annex (Canada, Poland and the United States). Of these, only the United States has given reasons code by code, while the other administrations simply gave one or several reasons for all the headings and subheadings for which they have requested retention.
7. It is worth recalling that the Sub-Committee agreed not to systematically retain codes where a request was made by only one Contracting Party (with an exception for the developing countries). The Secretariat therefore leaves it to the Sub-Committee to judge, case by case, whether to retain the codes.

ANNEX II

8. This Annex lists a series of codes (3 headings and 31 subheadings) which (1) do not meet the threshold criterion and (2) do not satisfy any of the exception principles adopted by the HSC. Like Annex I, this Annex also mentions the Contracting Parties that have requested retention and the Secretariat's comments.
9. Deletion of the codes is technically feasible. However, certain elements (for example, structure of the HS, upward trend in trade) referred to by the Secretariat in its comments may support retention of these codes. In Annex II the Secretariat has divided the codes into two categories :
 - those for which retention seems desirable "**RETAIN**"
 - those for which deletion can be envisaged "**RSC**".

10. Draft amendments to the HS are shown in square brackets in Annex IV for codes which are marked "**RSC**" in Annex II, except for the subheadings of heading 68.12 (see the comments on the subheadings of that heading).

ANNEX III

11. This Annex lists the codes which do not satisfy the threshold criterion but should be retained on the basis of the exceptions agreed upon by the HSC. This Annex corresponds to Annex III to Doc. 42.233 plus the codes listed in Annexes I and II to that document, for which there are at least two requests for retention. This Annex is issued for information purposes, as instructed by the Sub-Committee (see Doc. 42.500, Annex C/1, paragraph 6 – RSC/18, Report).

ANNEX IV

12. This bilingual Annex contains the draft amendments to the HS Nomenclature that follow from the possible deletion of (1) the codes mentioned in Annex I and (2) certain codes listed in Annex II (see paragraph 10 above).
13. The texts concerning the codes listed in Annex II are set out in square brackets. Also in square brackets are the texts concerning the following codes of Annex I : 2620.50 (waste) and 7415.31 (two alternatives are proposed).

III CONCLUSIONS

14. The Sub-Committee is invited to :
- rule on the Secretariat proposals for deletion of the HS heading and subheadings set out in Annex I, taking into account the relevant trade statistics (see Doc. 41.817, Annex I (RSC/17)) and the Secretariat's comments. Attention is drawn to the fact that one four-digit heading is included in that list, and the texts for subheadings 2620.50 and 7415.31 are in square brackets;
 - examine whether it is appropriate to delete or retain the codes set out in Annex II, taking account of the Secretariat's proposals and comments in that Annex;
 - approve the list of codes to be retained, set out in Annex III;
 - examine and approve the draft amendments to the HS set out in Annex IV.

- 1207.92 : Considerable increase in 1996 (1993 : USD 80.000, 1994 : USD 89.000, 1995 : USD 2.9 millions, 1996 : USD 15.6 millions) according to data from the EC. The Secretariat has not been able to check whether this is a true increase or whether there is an error in the data supplied.
- 1402.10 and
1402.90 : Very low trade volume, in constant decline (around USD 5.5 million for heading 14.02 in 1996). Two regrouping possibilities :
- (a) Transfer of heading 14.02 to subheading 1404.90
(b) Retention of heading 14.02 but regrouping of subheadings : "1402.00"
Deletion of 14.02 would affect Note 3 to Chapter 14.
Given the time available for finalizing this dossier the Secretariat proposes, as a preliminary measure, to delete the two subheadings.
- 2620.50 : This is waste. Any checks could be carried out under the residual subheading which also covers waste. The Secretariat points out that the HSC adopted provisionally for this heading some amendment proposals that would give separate mention to other wastes (see Doc. 40.260, Annex M/1, HSC/17 – Report).
- 2816.20 and
2816.30 : The United States has raised an environmental problem. The Secretariat feels that any checks could be carried out under the new subheading 2816.40 which would cover only the two categories of product concerned. It is worth noting that trade in goods of subheading 2816.20 is very slight (1993 : USD 335.000, 1994 : USD 951.000, 1995 : USD 1,2 million, 1996 : USD 1 million).
- 3702.91,
3702.92 : Trade is in constant decline. The proposed regrouping would cause a change in the scope of subheading 3702.91, without renumbering. The Secretariat feels that this is no obstacle to such an amendment.
- 3817.20 : This heading has no residual subheading, so that the deletion of subheading 3817.20 would also entail deletion of subheading 3817.10 which meets the threshold criterion. Given the low volume of trade for subheading 3817.20 (USD 3.1 million in 1996), this regrouping seems feasible.

7415.31 : There are two regrouping alternatives :

(a) Regrouping of all screws in one subheading (regrouping of subheading 7415.31 and subheading 7415.32), which would avoid possible identification problems when differentiating between screws for wood and other screws :

"7415.33 -- Screws; bolts and nuts" **or**

(b) Transfer of screws for wood from subheading 7415.31 to subheading 7415.39 by amending the wording of subheading 7415.32, but without altering its scope:

"7415.32 -- Screws other than screws for wood, bolts and nuts "
