#### I. BACKGROUND

1. Due to lack of time, the Review Sub-Committee postponed discussions on the proposed amendment of Note 5 to Chapter 84 and the consequential amendment to heading 84.71, as set out in the Annex to Doc. NR0421E1, and the proposal presented by Japan in Doc. NR0461E1.

#### II. SECRETARIAT COMMENTS

- 2. The Secretariat has reproduced the two proposed draft amendments to Note 5 to Chapter 84 (i.e., the proposal by Japan and the Secretariat's proposal) in the Annex to this document. For its comments on its own proposal and for clarification of the Japanese proposal, reference is made to documents NR0421E1 and NR0461E1, respectively.
- 3. With respect to the Japanese proposal, the Secretariat would like to merely point out that in that proposal, the distinction between digital machines, analogue machines and hybrid machines will be maintained, whereas the Secretariat's proposal no longer makes this distinction. It is, however, not entirely clear to the Secretariat whether the amendment proposed by Japan should be considered as substituting the complete Secretariat's proposal and, consequently, undo the list of units to be excluded from heading 84.71, which will have

their own headings, or refers to part (A) of the latter proposal only. Japan may wish to clarify this point.
