IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DECISIONS TAKEN BY THE HARMONIZED SYSTEM CCOMMITTEE AT ITS 25th SESSION (Item II.3 on Agenda)

NC0250E2 (HSC/25 - Report) NG0018E1 (HSC/25)

- 1. The Annex to Doc. NG0018E1 listed the decisions of the Harmonized System Committee's 25th Session to be approved under the procedure laid down in Article 8.2 of the Harmonized System Convention.
- 2. The period of two months allowed for lodging a request that any of these decisions be referred to the Council or directly back to the HSC for re-examination (see Council Decision No. 298) expired on 31 May 2000.
- 3. By that date, four such requests had been lodged :
 - One by the Argentine Administration concerning the "<u>classification of the "Color</u> <u>QuickCam"</u>" (Doc. NC0250E2/H/5)
 - One by the Australian Administration concerning the "<u>classification of "high fat cream</u> <u>cheese</u>""(Doc. NC0250E2/H/10)
 - One by the Brazilian Administration concerning the "<u>classification of the "TATA SUMO</u> <u>483" motor vehicle</u>" (Doc. NC0250E2/H/15)
 - One by the Polish Administration concerning the "<u>classification of a tobacco mixture</u> <u>known as "Basic Blended Strip</u>"" (Doc. NC0250E2/IJ/20).
- 4. The Australian Administration requested that its question be referred to the Council and the Argentine, Brasilian and Polish Administrations requested that their questions be referred directly back to the HSC.
