## ESTABLISHMENT OF A CORRELATION BETWEEN THE HARMONIZED SYSTEM AND VARIOUS INTERNATIONAL CONVENTIONS

(Item III.2 on Agenda)

#### I. BACKGROUND

- 1. At its 21<sup>st</sup> Session, the Harmonized System Committee examined a proposal by the US Administration aimed at establishing a correlation between the HS and various international conventions. Following discussion, the Committee decided in favour of the publication, by the Secretariat, of an unofficial file establishing such a correlation.
- 2. At its 22<sup>nd</sup> Session, the Committee continued its examination of this proposal. The Committee drew up certain guidelines regarding the status, presentation, publication and content of the correlation table and noted that the Secretariat would continue its work with a view to finalizing the draft. The relevant part of the principles with regard to the guidelines drawn up at the 22<sup>nd</sup> Session of the HS Committee is set out in Annex I to this document.
- 3. At its 27<sup>th</sup> Session, the Harmonized System Committee examined the draft correlation proposed by the Secretariat. During the course of the discussion on this item, it was pointed out that the definitions of "X" and "EX" in Note 2 to the Table of Doc. NC0409E1 should be reviewed with a view to further improvement. Concerning the status of the correlation, one delegate expressed the view that it should be unofficial and should not have legal status, and that this notion should be clearly stated in the correlation. In this context, it was suggested

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that the term "INFORMAL" should be inserted before "CORRELATION" in the title of the Annex to Doc. NC0409E1. Insertion of the word "UNOFFICIAL" was also suggested.

4. Finally, the Committee agreed to continue discussion of this agenda item at its next session and the Secretariat was instructed to prepare a new document taking into account the comments mentioned above, further discussions with the UNEP and, possibly, the WTO Secretariats and other relevant information.

#### II. SECRETARIAT COMMENTS

- 5. As instructed by the Committee, the Secretariat contacted the UNEP and the WTO for further information.
- 6. As regards hazardous wastes controlled by the Basel Convention, the UNEP provided the WCO Secretariat with their draft correlation tables between the HS and the various lists of wastes. Their tables also contain the list of wastes controlled by the OECD. The Secretariat has finalized the draft correlation table based on the new information provided by the UNEP as set out in Annex II to this document.
- 7. During the intersession the Secretariat sent a letter to the WTO, however, at the time of preparing of this document, no additional information has been provided on this issue by the WTO. With respect to this issue, the WTO Observer had indicated in the past that her organization would not, in principle, be opposed to such a correlation, subject to certain conditions, though she noted that the WTO was still examining the question and might conceivably conclude that the correlation would be of little use (see Annex C/3 to Doc. 42.750, paragraph 4). In this connection, the Secretariat would note that the Agreement on Civil Aircraft had been accepted in December 1986 and that the Annex had not been amended since then and was consequently not up to date. The Secretariat therefore considers it premature for the correlation table to contain references to the WTO instruments.
- 8. With regard to the other instruments, i.e., the Montreal Protocol relating to ozone layer depleting substances, CITES, the Convention with regard to narcotics, etc. and the Chemical Weapons Convention, the Secretariat has not made any modifications to the draft correlation in the Annex to Doc. NC0409E1 (see Annex II to this document) (see also paragraphs 10 to 13 of Doc. NC0409E1). In this connection, it should be noted that symbols in the "CITES" column, which appear to have been affected by the HS 2002 amendments are underlined for the purposes of the Committee's examination.
- 9. Taking into account paragraphs 5 to 8 above, and in view of the principles drawn up by the Committee as mentioned in Annex I to this document, the Secretariat considers it most appropriate that the correlation should have the following structure and would therefore propose the publication as set out in Annex II to this document:
  - I. INTRODUCTION
  - II. LIST OF CONVENTIONS AND THEIR ORGANIZATIONS
  - III. CONTACT DETAILS RE THE ORGANIZATIONS ADMINISTERING THE CONVENTIONS

- IV. TABLE (Correlation between the product coverage of selected international conventions and the HS).
- 10. With respect to insertion of the term "INFORMAL" or "UNOFFICIAL" in the title of the draft correlation (see paragraph 3 above), the Secretariat would draw the Committee's attention to the fact that the text of the second paragraph of "I. INTRODUCTION" is based on the Correlation Tables for the HS 1996 and 2002 amendments and the "TABLE ESTABLISHING AN INTERCONNECTION BETWEEN THE HS AND CITES" (Annex I to the Explanatory Notes to the HS). It should be noted that it is clearly indicated that the status of those publications, published by the Secretariat, is unofficial and they do not have legal status. The above referenced publications did not use the term "INFORMAL" or "UNOFFICIAL" in their titles. Taking account of the above, the Secretariat considers that insertion of the term "INFORMAL" or "UNOFICIAL" would be superfluous. Nonetheless, the Secretariat leaves it to the Committee to decide. The text concerned has been placed in square brackets (see Annex II to this document, page II/1).
- 11. Concerning the definitions of "X" and "EX" in Note 2 to the Table (see paragraph 3 above), the Secretariat has prepared revised texts and leaves it to the Committee to decide on their acceptability (see Annex II to this document, page II/3).
- 12. With regard to the publication of the correlation in hard copy, although it was originally agreed that it would be published as an Annex to the Explanatory Notes (see paragraph 5 of Annex I to this document), the Secretariat proposes that it should be published as an Annex to the Classification Handbook.
- 13. With regard to publication on the WCO Web Site, the Secretariat would draw the Committee's attention to the fact that the Committee, at its 22<sup>nd</sup> Session, already decided that the exhaustive lists of products controlled by the various international organizations should **not** be published as an Annex to the file disseminated via the Internet (see Annex C/3 to Doc. 42.750, paragraphs 3 and 8). Based on this decision, "I. INTRODUCTION", "II. LIST OF CONVENTIONS AND THEIR ORGANIZATIONS" and "III. CONTACT DETAILS RE THE ORGANIZATIONS ADMINISTERING THE CONVENTIONS" (except "**Notes**") will be disseminated via the Internet. "IV. TABLE" will, however, not be published.

#### III. CONCLUSION

- 14. The Committee is invited to examine the draft correlation between the product coverage of selected international conventions and the HS, set out in Annex II to this document, taking into account the Secretariat comments above.
- 15. The Committee is also invited to express its view with regard to the publication of the correlation, taking into account the Secretariat comments as set out in paragraphs 10 to 13.

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#### PRINCIPLES DRAWN UP BY THE COMMITTEE AT ITS 22<sup>nd</sup> SESSION

#### Status

1. The correlation will be unofficial and be compiled by the WCO Secretariat in conjunction with the Secretariats of the organizations administering the conventions or agreements concerned.

#### Presentation

2. The correlation table will comprise solely the HS codes covered by one (or more) convention(s), opposite which symbols will be indicated when one (or more) goods of the subheading are controlled by the convention mentioned in the header of the corresponding column. The symbol will differ according to whether all the products covered by the code or only some of them are covered by the relevant convention. The table will be preceded by a preamble specifying its status, scope and objectives and providing practical information on its use.

#### **Content**

- 3. The correlation will include all the instruments mentioned in Annex I to Doc. NC0010E1, provided that the organizations administering them agree. Furthermore, although it would be preferable to have the various lists fully reflect the goods, it may be necessary for the correlation to be limited to the most frequently traded controlled products in certain cases (especially in the case of CITES). Accordingly, a flexible procedure (case by case) will be applied.
- 4. The correlation should also contain (1) information concerning the organization administering the instrument concerned (contact details, direct link with the organization's Internet sites, etc.), enabling users to access the convention texts and the lists of products controlled and (2) general information concerning each Convention, to be inserted at the request of the organization responsible for administering the Convention.

#### Publication

5. The correlation will not only be made available on the WCO's Web site, enabling it to be consulted and if necessary downloaded by users, but will also be published on paper as an Annex to the Explanatory Notes, like the existing Annex establishing an interconnection between the HS and CITES.

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# [INFORMAL][UNOFFICIAL] CORRELATION BETWEEN THE PRODUCT COVERAGE OF SELECTED INTERNATIONAL CONVENTIONS AND THE HARMONIZED SYSTEM

#### I. INTRODUCTION

This publication contains the correlations between the Harmonized System and selected international conventions as drawn by the World Customs Organization Secretariat in collaboration with the Secretariats of the organizations administering the conventions or agreements set out below, in accordance with instructions received from the Harmonized System Committee.

Although the attached table was examined by the Harmonized System Committee, it is not to be regarded as reflecting classification decisions taken by that Committee; it constitutes a reference published by the WCO Secretariat for the purpose of facilitating the monitoring and control of certain products covered by other international conventions. The table is non-exhaustive and merely indicative and has **no legal or official status**.
