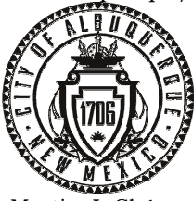
The Many Worlds of Rudolfo Anaya

September 1 – October 13, 2007

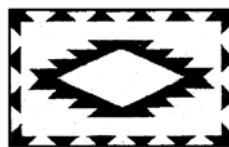
