



1. You will receive an e-mail like the one below. Click on the link to begin the renewal process.

3. Click on the Renew button.




4. The VeriSign Personal Trust Agent pop-up will appear. Select the certificate from the list that you are attempting to renew. Click the Renew button.

6. The following pop-up will appear. Click on the Yes button.




7. Click on the Set Security Level button.



8. Select a security level of High and click the Next button.




9. Enter your password to protect your renewed certificate. Note: You may use the same password for your renewed certificate as your current one. Click the Finish button after you enter and confirm your password.




10. Click the OK button.




11. When this page is displayed, your renewal request has been successfully entered.




12. After you complete your renewal request, you will receive an e-mail similar to the one below.




13. Once the Certificate Administrator has approved your request, you will receive an e-mail similar to the one below. Click on the link to begin the Pick Up ID process.
