IF THIS PROPOSAL MEETS WITH YOUR APPROVAL, PLEASE DELIVER THE FOLLOWING MESSAGE FROM ME TO HIS IMPERIAL MAJESTY AT ONCE, WITH THE SIGNED LETTER TO FOLLOW. DETAILS OF EXACT TIME AND DURATION OF HALLOCK'S FIRST WORKING VISIT WILL BE WORKED OUT WITH GENERAL BRETT AND BE COORDINATED WITH YOU.

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HR70-14 (U) The Accordance with our conversation in washington about possible special assistance in the areas of resource management and force analysis, i have sent, as you know, the personal consultant, mr fidded R. Hallock (who was also associated with me in our budget bureau) to become acquainted with the situation in armish maag and the imperial iranian army with a view to determining in what way this department might be of assistance. As you know, i place great stress on the importance of our insuring that the equipment we provide is satisfaction fory for your purposes and on our assisting in its effective. Ness of your programs in the shortest possible time. The stabilitythat your country brings to its part of the world in its own sovereign interest also is a benefit of much significan to the united states.

MR. WEALLOCK HAS REPORTED TO ME THE WHOLE HEARTED COOPERATION THAT HE RECEIVED FROM THE CHIEF OF THE SUPREME COMMANDER'S STAFF AND HIS STAFF MEMBERS, FROM THE COMMANDERS OF THE IMPERIAL AIR FORCE, GROUND FORCE, AND NAVY AND FROM THE VICE MINISTER OF WAR FOR ARMA-MENTS DURING THE COURSE OF HIS VISIT, AND THE COURTESIES EXTENDED

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TO HIM. HE WAS TREMENDOUSLY IMPRESSED WITH THE HIGH DEGREE OF ACTIVITY AND THE DEVELOPMENT IN BOTH THE IRANIAN ARMY AND IN THE DOMESTIC BEONDMY, AND IN THE STABILITY OF THE COUNTRY AND THE WISDON AND VISION OF YOUR IMPERIAL MAJESTY AS DISPLAYED IN THESE YESULTS. MR HALLOCK WAS AWARE BEFORE HE APPIVED IN IRAN AND FURTHER ACQUAINTEDE HIMSELF WHILE THERE OF THE ROLES THAT ARE FLAYED UNDER YOUR DIRECTION BY THE CUPREMEN COMMANDER'S STAFF, THE COMMANDERS OF THE IMPERIAL ALR FORCE, GROUND FORCE AND NAVY, AND THE VICE MINISTER FOR ADMAMENTS AND OTHERS. HE UNDERSTANDS AND MADE IT CLEAR TO HE THAT WHAT-EVER HELP IT MAY BE FOSSIBLE TO PROVIDE MUST NOT DISTURB THE ROLES THAT YOU HAVE BOTADLISHED FOR YOUR KEN OFFICIALS AND MORE WARDLING.

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MR. HALLOCK'S REVIEW WAS CARRIED OUT, AS YOU KNOW, IN FULL COORDINATION WITH GENERAL BRETT WHO'IS MY PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE THE TRANSME AND WHO MADE EVERY ARMISH MAAG FACILITY AVAILABLE TO HIM. MR. HALLOCK REPORTED TO ME THAT HE FOUND THE U.S. ARMISH MAAG PERSONNEL tO BE OF THE BEST QUALITY THAT HE HAS SEEN IN OUR MAAGS

ANYWHERE. HE ALSO COMMENTED ON THE EXCELLENT WORKING RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN YOUR DEFENSE OFFICIALS AND THEIR U.S. ADVISORS.

MR HALLOCK'S REACTION WAS THAT YOUR DEFENSE PROGRAMS SHOW GREAT

VIEWN AND A LONG-RANGE STRATEGIC OUTLOOK. HE FEELS THAT WE CAN AND SHOULD DO MORE TO INTEGRATE OUR ARMISH MAAG STAFF ADVIAE, ESPEC-IAIALY TO ASSIST YOU IN IDENTIFYING POSSIBLE LONGER RANGE BOTTLE-NECKS, IN YOUR PROGRAMS SO THAT THEY CAN BE ANTICIPATED AND ELIMINATED. THESE ARE COMPLEX PROGRAMS WITH HIGH DEMANDS, ON RESOURCES AND HIGH LEVEL MANAGEMENT. HE FEELS, FOR EXAMPLE, THAT A PROJECTION OF TOTAL MANFOWER (ESPECIALLY IN THE AREAS OF COMPETING SKILLS) AND OTHER RESOURCES AGAINST YOUR VISUALIZED REQUIREMENTS OVER A LONGER TIME PERIOD THAN IS INHERENT IN THE FIVE YEAR PLAN WOULD BE USEFUL AND COMPLIMENTARY TO THAT PLAN. HE TEELS THERE ALSO MAY BE WAYS TO DETTER RELATE THE THERATS, THEIR THRETED WAR PASKS, AND THEIR PRIOR-TITLES IN WAYS WHICH MAY GAVE YOU BOTH TIME AND RESOURCES IN FORCE DEVELOPMENT AND RAPID ATTAINMENT OF FULL

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COMBAT EMPECTIVENESS, ALTHOUGH THIS LATTER PHASE WILL BE VERY SEN SITES AND REQUIRE, SAN SUNE, TOUR PERSONAL INTERBOT AND CONCROL. HE ALSO BELIEVES THAT "COMPUTERIZING" THE FUNCTIONS OF THE SUPREME COMMANDER'S STAFF WILL BE MORE RAPIDLY AND EFFECTIVELY ACHIEVED IF THIS EFFORT IS DELAYED UNTIL HE CAN WORK WITH GENERAL BRETT'S AND YOUR STAFF. MR. HALLOCK BELIEVES THAT IMPROVEMENTS IN LONGER RANGE PLANNING AND FORCE ANALYSIS CAN BE BEST ACHIEVED BY DEVELOPING THE CONSISTING OF APPROPRIATE PORTIONS OF THE JOINT STAFF OF THE ANAG, WHICH IN TURN SHOULD CONCURRENTLY IMPROVA THE CAPABILI-DIES OF YOUR OWN STAFF AND OTHER ELEMENTS THAT YOU DESIGNATE. THIS WOULD BE DONE BY HAVING MR. HALLOCK VISIT INITIALLY TO ORGANIZE THE WORK AND THEREAFTER VISIT PERIODICALLY. DURING THESE VISITS HE WILL BE AVAILABLE TO WORK BOTH DIRECTLY WITH YOUR PEOPLE AND WITH THE MAAG STAFF AS MY REPRESENTATTIVE SPONSORED BY GENERAL BRETT. HE WOULD ALSO BE AVAILABLE TO PROVIDE ADVICE TO GENERAL BRETT IN SPECIAL AREAS OF WEAPON AVAILABILITIES AND CAPABILITIES. MR. HALLOCK FEELS STRONGLY THAT IT IS BEST FOR HIS TEAM VISITS TO BE PERIODIC SO THAT. THE U.S. RESPONSIBILITY REMAINS WITH THE ARMISH MAAG AND THE INITIA-TIVE FOR ACCOMPLISHING THE WORK THAT HE SUGGESTS AND INITIATES REMAINS IN IRAN.

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IF YOU DO NOT OBJECT, I PLAN TO HAVE MR. HALLOCK VISIT IRAN PER-IGDICALLY FOR TWO OR THREE WEEKS WITH ONE OR TWO OTHER PEOPLE OF HIS CHOICE AS MAY BE NEEDED TO ASSIST GENERAL BRETT'IN DEVELOPING HIS STAFF AND IN COLLABORATING WITH YOUR PERSONNEL IN A BROADER RESOURCE PLANNING AND FORCE ALAYSIS EFFORT. IN ORDER TO GET ON WITH THE WORK RAPIDLY, I SUGGEST THAT THE FIRST VISIT TAKE PLACE IN MID OR LATE JANUARY. MEANWHILE MR. HALLOCK AND GENERAL BRETT HAVE DISCUSSED MATTERS SUFFICIENTLY THAT GENERAL BRETT WILL BE TAKING PREPARATORY MEASURES INTERNAL TO THE ARMISH MAAG EVEN IN ADVANCE OF MR. HAL-

AND HAS HAD EXPERIENCE IN WEAPONS SYSTEMS ANALYSIS, OPERATIONAL TEST EVALUATION, FORCE STRUCTURE ANALYSIS, ECONOMIC ANALYSIS AND OTHER RELEVANT SKILLS WHICH HE HAS APPLIED BOTH IN THE U.S. AND ABROAD.
