

Would you please be good enough to pass the following message from me to Donald Rumsfeld: BEGIN TEXT Former Secretary of the Treasury David Kennedy has been visiting Tehran for a few days on business and has had some interesting conversations, particularly one with the Minister of Economics and Finance, Hushang Ansary. May I encourage you to debrief David Kennedy when he returns to the United States since I believe what he has to say will be of use and interest to the President and you. He intends to seek you out.
