



- Comply with FAA Lighting Requirements to Minimize Avian Impacts
- Implement Adaptive Management Strategies

Policies and BMPs

- MMS Interim Policy announced November 2007
 - BMPs established December 2007
- 5-year Site Testing Leases
- Request for Lease Nominations
- Exclude Special Management Areas from Development
- Consult with National Marine Fisheries, FWS, and Coastal Zone Management entities
- Surveys to Minimize and Mitigate Avian Loss
- Reduce Perching
- Avoid Nesting Beaches
- Comply with FAA and USCG Lighting to Minimize Avian Impacts
- Implement Adaptive Management Strategies
