Staff's Recommendation for Final Rule to Amend the Flammability Standard for Clothing Textiles

(Briefing package dated January 11, 2008, OS No. 3776)

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (2-0) to direct the Office of General Counsel to prepare a draft *Federal Register* notice for a final rule amending the Flammability Standard for Clothing Textiles, 16 C.F.R. Part 1610, in accordance with the recommendations of the staff. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to modify the current procedures to reflect the existence of modern equipment and current consumer care practices, and to provide clarification on several aspects of the standard. The staff observed that the proceeding does not include any proposal to change the classification criteria of the clothing textiles standard or provide for changes to the exemptions to the standard.
