

<p><b>PHYSICALLY SEPARATE BUSINESSES</b></p>	<p>Facilities housing <b>dogs, cats, or nonhuman primates</b> must be physically separated from other businesses on the same premises. [3.1(b), 3.75(b)]</p>
<p><b>Examples</b></p>	<p>Other businesses include, but are not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• another exhibitor on the same property</li> <li>• retail sales of other animals</li> <li>• training facility</li> </ul>
<p><b>Criteria</b></p>	<p>Examples of physical separation include, but are not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• solid wall between the businesses in the same building</li> <li>• divider/barrier of sufficient height to denote a clear separation between businesses</li> <li>• fence (perimeter) not part of primary enclosure</li> <li>• separate entrances into separate animal areas in same building</li> <li>• separate buildings</li> <li>• restricted access between businesses</li> <li>• no common walls</li> </ul>
