

<b>MARKINGS AND LABELING</b>	Transport enclosures must be properly labeled. [3.14, 3.36, 3.61, 3.81, 3.113, 3.137]
<b>Criteria</b>	A removable transport enclosure is properly labeled if it contains: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• markings on the top and one or more sides of the enclosure</li><li>• directional arrows indicating the upright position</li><li>• the words<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ “Live Animal” (see page 13.5.2)</li><li>➤ in letters at least 1" in height</li><li>➤ on top of the enclosure and on one or more sides</li></ul></li></ul>
<b>Species Specific</b>	<b>Nonhuman Primates</b> [3.87(f)] Removable and permanently affixed transport enclosures must contain the words in English “Wild Animal” or “Live Animal”.  <b>Marine Mammals</b> [3.113(f)] The transport enclosure, when not permanently affixed to the cargo space, must be marked: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• with the words “Live Animal” or “Wild Animal”</li><li>• on top (when present), and</li><li>• on at least one side, or</li><li>• on all sides whenever possible</li></ul> <b>Other Animals</b> [3.137(e)] <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The words “Wild Animal” may also be used.</li></ul>
