## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE TO ISSUE A  
COMMEMORATIVE POSTAGE STAMP HONORING MUSICIAN AND  
ENTERTAINER, DON HO.

1 WHEREAS, Donald Tai Loy Ho, known to most of his many fans  
2 and admirers as Don Ho, was born on August 13, 1930, in  
3 Kaka'ako, on the island of O'ahu, of Hawaiian, Chinese,  
4 Portuguese, Dutch, and German heritage; and  
5

6 WHEREAS, Don Ho entertained generations of people in Hawaii  
7 and on the mainland alike with his live musical shows in Hawaii  
8 and on the mainland, and on television shows such as "The Don Ho  
9 Show," "The Brady Bunch," "Batman," and "Charlie's Angels,"  
10 until his death in 2007; and

12 WHEREAS, Don Ho's live musical show "The Don Ho Show," now  
13 known as "The Ohana Ho Show," allowed and continues to allow  
14 young, promising musicians and artists the opportunity to  
15 perform and enhance their musical talents, earning Don Ho the  
16 reputation as the musical ambassador of Hawaii; and

18 WHEREAS, Don Ho made history by becoming one of the most  
19 famous entertainers from Hawaii, with his love and talent for  
20 music and humor; now, therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
23 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular  
24 Session of 2008, the Senate concurring, that the United States  
25 Postmaster General is requested to issue a Don Ho Commemorative  
26 Stamp; and


28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Citizen's Stamp Advisory  
29 Committee is requested to recommend to the United States  
30 Postmaster General that a Don Ho Commemorative Stamp be issued;

3 United States, the members of Hawaii's Congressional Delegation,  
4 the United States Postmaster General, and the Governor of the
