
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO DEVELOP NUTRITIONALLY-
SOUND PUBLIC SCHOOL MENU PLANS THAT GIVE STUDENTS THE
OPTION OF A VEGETARIAN SCHOOL LUNCH MEAL.

1 WHEREAS, during the extensive period of time they spend at
2 school, students should be provided with nutritious food and
3 drinks to help them mature in developmentally-appropriate ways;
4 and
5

6 WHEREAS, the American Academy of Pediatrics, American
7 Cancer Society, American Dietetic Association, American Heart
8 Association, and National Institutes of Health now recommend
9 that there be greater emphasis in the American diet on fruits,
10 vegetables, and whole grains; and
11

12 WHEREAS, fruits and vegetables promote good health because
13 they contain fiber and essential nutrients including vitamins
14 and minerals, are low in fat and calories, contain
15 phytochemicals that may provide additional protection to reduce
16 the risk of cancer and heart disease, and contain no
17 cholesterol; and
18

19 WHEREAS, all the essential organic nutrients in the human
20 diet are synthesized by plants and microorganisms; and
21

22 WHEREAS, increasing awareness of the importance of eating
23 five or more servings of fruits and vegetables a day for better
24 health should begin in the schools; and
25

26 WHEREAS, a significant minority of Hawaii school children
27 identify themselves as vegetarian or vegan - they use no animal
28 products - or come from vegetarian or vegan families; and

30 WHEREAS, these children are at a disadvantage if no
31 vegetarian school lunches are offered at their schools; and

1 WHEREAS, all students should be assured nutritionally-
2 balanced diets regardless of their food preferences and
3 avoidances; now, therefore,
4

5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
6 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
7 Session of 2008, the Senate concurring, that the Department of
8 Health is requested to work in collaboration with the Department
9 of Agriculture, the Department of Education, and Hawaii's school
10 food service to develop nutritionally-sound public school menu
11 plans that give students the option of a vegetarian school lunch
12 meal; and

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Health, in
15 cooperation with the Department of Education, is requested to
16 submit to the Legislature, no later than twenty days prior to
17 the convening of the Regular Session of 2009, a report on the
18 public school menu plans that have been developed and
19 implemented to provide nutritionally-sound public school menu
20 plans including the option of vegetarian school lunch meals; and

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
23 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Health,
24 the Chair of the Board of Education, the Superintendent of
25 Education, and the Chair of the Board of Agriculture.
