
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE ON THE IMPACT OF THE STEEL WHEELS ON RAIL TECHNOLOGY PROPOSED AS THE MASS TRANSIT OPTION FOR OAHU ON WAIPAHU HIGH SCHOOL AND WAIPAHU INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL WITH RESPECT TO NOISE AND VIBRATION.

1 WHEREAS, on February 22, 2008, a five-member independent
2 technology-selection expert panel concluded that steel wheels on
3 rail technology offered the best combination of reliability,
4 capability, and cost for Oahu's proposed mass transit project;
5 and

7 WHEREAS, Waipahu High School is located a mere fifty yards
8 from the proposed steel wheels on rail mass transit route and
9 Waipahu Intermediate School is also in close proximity to the
10 proposed route; and
11

12 WHEREAS, the buildings making up Waipahu High School and
13 Waipahu Intermediate School do not have air conditioning to act
14 as partial insulation against the noise and vibration projected
15 to be caused by the construction and operation of the rail mass
16 transit system; and

18 WHEREAS, it is unclear how the learning environment at
19 Waipahu High School and Waipahu Intermediate School will be
20 affected by noise and vibration generated by the construction
21 and operation of the mass transit system; now, therefore,
22

23 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
24 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
25 Session of 2008, the Senate concurring, that the Council of the
26 City and County of Honolulu is requested to report to the
27 Legislature on the impact of the steel wheels on rail technology
28 proposed as the mass transit option for Oahu on Waipahu High

1 School and Waipahu Intermediate School with respect to noise and
2 vibration; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council of the City and
5 County of Honolulu is requested to include in the report
6 ameliorative measures to mitigate the negative impact of the
7 noise and vibration from the construction and operation of the
8 mass transit system; and

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council of the City and
11 County of Honolulu is requested to submit the report to the
12 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
13 the Regular Session of 2009; and

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
16 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor and the
17 Chairperson of the Council of the City and County of Honolulu,
18 the Governor, the Director of Transportation, and the
19 Superintendent and the Chairperson of the Board of Education.
