
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A SUNRISE REVIEW OF LICENSURE
OF INTERIOR DESIGNERS.

1 WHEREAS, interior designers are currently an unregulated
2 profession in this State; and

3
4 WHEREAS, it may benefit and protect the citizens of the
5 State to require the licensing of interior designers and
6 prohibit the use of the designation licensed "interior designer"
7 by unlicensed persons; and

9 WHEREAS, H.B. No. (2008) proposes to regulate the
10 interior design profession; and

11
12 WHEREAS, legal recognition, achieved through licensure,
13 safeguards the health, safety, and welfare of the general public
14 and brings uniformity to the profession; and

16 WHEREAS, section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires
17 that new regulatory measures that would subject unregulated
18 professions and vocations to licensing or other regulatory
19 controls be referred to the Auditor for analysis; now,
20 therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
23 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
24 Session of 2008, the Senate concurring, that the Auditor is
25 requested to conduct a sunrise review of the licensure of
26 interior designers as contemplated under H.B. No. (2008); and

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to
29 submit findings and recommendations, including any proposed
30 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
31 to the regular session of 2009; and
