A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE AFTER-SCHOOL PLUS PROGRAM REVOLVING FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature reaffirms its intent to support
- 2 the after-school plus program revolving fund primarily through
- 3 program participant fees. The legislature, however, finds that
- 4 the program is also being supported in part by general fund
- 5 appropriations and funds from the department of human services
- 6 for child care for eligible low income children.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to limit deposits into the
- revolving fund to only those funds that are collected as fees or 8
- 9 charges for participation in the program and the interest earned
- 10 on the revolving fund deposits.
- SECTION 2. Section 302A-1149.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, 11
- 12 is amended to read as follows:

- 14 fund. (a) There is established in the state treasury the
- 15 after-school plus program revolving fund to be administered by
