## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LEGAL SERVICE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 28-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: "§28-10 Prohibition on private practice of law by the 3 4 attorney general, first deputy, and other deputies. (a) The 5 attorney general, the attorney general's first deputy, and other 6 deputies shall devote their entire time and attention to the 7 duties of their respective offices. They shall not engage in 8 the private practice of law, [nor] or accept any fees or emoluments other than their official salaries for any legal 9 10 services [+]; provided that, except for the attorney general's 11 first deputy, a deputy may provide pro bono legal services if 12 the pro bono legal services do not create a conflict of interest 13 with the duties of the deputy's office.
- 14 (b) This section shall not apply to any special deputy
- 15 employed on a part-time basis for a limited period."
- 16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. HB2391 HD1 HMS 2008-2628
