
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WORKERS' COMPENSATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-430, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows: 2 3 "§302A-430 Coverage for workers' compensation. Whenever a 4 student participating in a school-approved work-based learning 5 program sponsored by the department of education or the University of Hawaii undertakes to perform work for a private or 6 7 public employer as part of the student's work-based learning 8 program, whether paid or unpaid, the State shall be deemed to be 9 the responsible employer for the purposes of workers' 10 compensation coverage, that shall be the student's exclusive 11 remedy to the same extent as provided for in chapter 386 as 12 against the State and the private employer participating in the 13 program." 14 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored. 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 16
