## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WATER RATES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Agriculture in Hawaii depends on many factors, 1 including access to water for irrigation purposes at affordable 2 rates. Although many farmers are able to access lower 3 agricultural water rates provided by the county water systems, 4 other farmers who are unable to access the county water systems 5 must rely on the more expensive residential water rates provided 6 by public utilities. Without affordable water rates, 7 agriculture cannot be sustainable and competitive in Hawaii. 8 The legislature finds that it is in the public interest to 9 promote the long-term viability of agriculture by establishing 10 mechanisms that provide for preferential rates for potable water 11 used for agricultural activities. 12

13 The purpose of this Act is to establish a policy of 14 providing preferential potable water rates for agricultural 15 activities and to authorize the public utilities commission to 16 establish preferential water rates for potable water used for 17 agricultural activities.

1	SECTION 2. Chapter 269, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to read as follows:
3	"§269- Preferential water rates for agricultural
4	activities. (a) It is the policy of the State to promote the
5	long-term viability of agriculture by establishing mechanisms
6	that provide for preferential rates for potable water for
7	agricultural activities. The public utilities commission shall
8	have the authority to establish preferential rates for potable
9	water used for agricultural activities in a public utility's
10	service area.
11	(b) Upon receipt of a bona fide request for preferential
12	rates for potable water to be used for agricultural activities,
13	and proof that the customer engages in agricultural activities,
14	a public utility shall provide proposed preferential rates for
15	potable water to be used only for qualified agricultural
16	activities to the public utilities commission for approval. All
17	such rates approved by the public utilities commission shall be
18	subsidized by the potable water rates charged to other customers
19	of the public utility if required as determined by the public
20	utilities commission. In reviewing the proposed preferential
21	rates, the public utilities commission, in consultation with the
22	department of agriculture, may establish additional criteria to

1	qualify bona fide agribusinesses for water used solely for
2	agricultural activities. For rate cases initiated pursuant to
3	this section, the public utilities commission shall allow the
4	recovery of any reasonable unamortized costs incurred by the
5	public utility in its previous rate case; provided however, upon
6	full amortization of these costs, rates shall be adjusted
7	accordingly."
8	SECTION 3. Section 269-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
