## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO JUDICIARY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 601-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended as follows:

1. By amending subsection (a) to read:
"(a) The chief justice, with the approval of the supreme court, shall appoint an administrative director of the courts to assist the chief justice in directing the administration of the judiciary. The administrative director shall be a resident of the [state] state for a continuous period of three years prior to the administrative director's appointment, [a] shall be appointed without regard to chapter 76, and shall serve at the pleasure of the chief justice. The administrative director shall hold no other office or employment. Effective July 1 , 2004, the salary of the administrative director shall be as last recommended by the judicial salary commission. Effective July 1, [2007, and every six years thereaftex] 2008, the salary shall be [as last weemmended by the commision on salaxien pursuant to seetion $26-56$, unless disapproved by the
legislature an annual amount no less than $\$ 120,000$ and no
greater than $\$ 150,000$, as determined by the chief justice."
2. By amending subsection (c) to read:
"(c) The administrative director, with the approval of the chief justice, shall appoint a deputy administrative director of the courts without regard to chapter 76 and such assistants as may be necessary. The assistants shall be appointed without regard to chapter 76. [ffeetive July], 2000, the salay of the deputy admintratye directox shall be no greatex than pxoyided in seetion $26-52(3)$ and shatibedeterned by the ehief justiee based upon Effective July 1 , 2004, the salary of the deputy administrative director shall be as last recommended by the judicial salary commission. Effective July 1, 2008, the salary of the deputy administrative director shall be an annual amount no less than $\$ 115,000$ and no greater than $\$ 140,000$, as determined by the chief justice. The administrative director shall be provided with necessary office facilities."

SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
