11 WHEREAS, JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT OF HAWAII, INC. has created a 12 working partnership among business, military, and education 13 communities with the mission of ensuring that Hawaii's children 14 will have the opportunity to learn about the free-enterprise 15 system; and

WHEREAS, through 495 offices around the world, Junior Achievement reaches approximately seven million students a year in inner cities, suburbs, and rural areas; and 20

WHEREAS, JON DE MELLO started the Mountain Apple Company,
Inc. in 1974 which is Hawaii's largest full service

1 WHEREAS, JON DE MELLO is one of the individuals credited 2 with the renaissance of Hawaiian music, has won awards in the music industry, and was named Hawaii's Small Business Person of 3 the Year in 1997; and 4 5 WHEREAS, JOSEPH J. FERRARO co-founded Ferraro Choi and 6 Associates, Ltd., an environmentally oriented architectural and 7 interior design firm in February 1998, and in this sustainable 8 architecture practice, has expanded the boundaries of 9 10 architecture to encompass the total environment; and 11 WHEREAS, JOSEPH J. FERRARO's projects have included the 12 Crary Science and Technology Lab in Antarctica, and the 13 14 Admundsen-Scott South Pole Station and other LEED (Leadership in 15 Energy and Environmental Design) projects; and 16 WHEREAS, RICHARD HA founded Kea`au Banana in 1992 and 17 18 diversified the company by growing hydroponic vegetables in addition to bananas, renaming the company "Hamakua Springs 19 Country Farms"; and 20 21 WHEREAS, RICHARD HA's company was the first in the world to 22 be awarded the Eco O.K. certification (eco-friendly operations) 23 and is a stalwart in the community, donating foods and playing a 24 key role in helping the Hamakua Coast sugar plantations rebound 25 from the closure of the plantations in the 1990's; and 26 27 WHEREAS, PETER KIM founded the family-owned Yummy 28 29 Restaurant Group and took it to the apex of excellence in the food court market with food courts at the Ala Moana Center, the 30 31 Navy Exchange, the Mall at Pearl Harbor, and on the University 32 of Hawaii at Manoa's campus; and 33 WHEREAS, PETER KIM is well respected in the business 34 community and his company has won numerous awards, including the 35 Small Business Administration's "Young Entrepreneur of the Year 36 Award"; and 37 38 WHEREAS, on Friday, March 7, 2008, JON DE MELLO of Mountain 39 Apple Company, JOSEPH J.
