

HOUSE RESOLUTION

PROMOTING HAWAII AS THE WORLD'S INTERFAITH HARMONY CAPITAL.

WHEREAS, much of the violence in the world arises out of religious conflict; and

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WHEREAS, religious conflict is often the result of inadequate understanding of other religions; and

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WHEREAS, an effective means for minimizing misunderstanding between religions is to promote open channels of communication between religious faiths; and

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WHEREAS, the "aloha spirit" is recognized as an important aspect of the Hawaiian culture and arises from the concepts of understanding and acceptance; and

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WHEREAS, the "aloha spirit" has allowed various interfaith religious groups to promote dialogue and activities in a free and open manner and to draw participation from a broad base transcending religious faiths; and

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WHEREAS, because of the "aloha spirit" Hawaii is uniquely qualified to serve as a role model for the acceptance and promotion of interfaith religious activities; now, therefore,

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BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2008, that Hawaii should be promoted as the world's Interfaith Harmony Capital; and

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Hawaii serve as a role model for interfaith relations and host activities seeking to develop and promote interfaith relations; and

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to representatives of the following organizations or religious faiths: Baha'i, Buddhism, Christianity, Church Women United, Confucianism, Daoism, Hawaiian Spirituality, Hinduism, Islam, Knights of Columbus,
