## HOUSE RESOLUTION

PROMOTING HAWAII AS THE WORLD'S INTERFAITH HARMONY CAPITAL.

1 2 3	WHEREAS, much of the violence in the world arises out of religious conflict; and
4 5 6	WHEREAS, religious conflict is often the result of inadequate understanding of other religions; and
7 8 9	WHEREAS, an effective means for minimizing misunderstanding between religions is to promote open channels of communication between religious faiths; and
10 11 12 13	WHEREAS, the "aloha spirit" is recognized as an important aspect of the Hawaiian culture and arises from the concepts of understanding and acceptance; and
14 15 16 17 18	WHEREAS, the "aloha spirit" has allowed various interfaith religious groups to promote dialogue and activities in a free and open manner and to draw participation from a broad base transcending religious faiths; and
19 20 21 22 23	WHEREAS, because of the "aloha spirit", Hawaii is uniquely qualified to serve as a role model for the acceptance and promotion of interfaith religious activities; now, therefore,
24 25 26 27	BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2008, that Hawaii should be promoted as the world's Interfaith Harmony Capital; and
28 29 30 31 32	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Hawaii serve as a role model for interfaith relations and host activities seeking to develop and promote interfaith relations; and
32 33 34 35 36	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the All Believers Network, a non-profit organization incorporated in the State of Hawaii, is requested to establish the statewide interfaith steering committee consisting of representatives from the various

religious and interfaith organizations and groups in Hawaii, 1 including but not limited to: Baha'i, Buddhism, Christianity, 2 Church Women United, Confucianism, Daoism, Hawaiian 3 Spirituality, Hinduism, Islam, Knights of Columbus, Jainism, 4 Judaism, Mokichi Okada Association, Native Americans, Church of 5 Perfect Liberty, Quakers, Risshio Kosei Kai, the Salvation Army, 6 Seichi-No Ie, Shinnyo-En, Shinto, Sikhism, Sufism, Unitarian 7 Universalism, Unity, Zoroastrianism, All Believers Network, the 8 Interfaith Alliance, and the Open Table; and 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that members of the statewide 11 12 interfaith steering committee are requested to select a chairperson from amongst its members; and 13 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature requests that 15 the purpose of the statewide interfaith steering committee be to 16 develop and promote interfaith activities to further relations 17 between various religious faiths; and 18 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the statewide interfaith steering committee is requested to explore the possibility of 21 organizing a major international interfaith conference in Hawaii 22 to take place by 2011; and 23 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is requested that the statewide interfaith steering committee be terminated on 26 27 June 30, 2011; and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the interfaith steering committee 30 at 781 Eleele Place, Honolulu, Hawaii 96825, which is in turn 31 requested to transmit copies to representatives of each of the 32 faiths and organizations listed in this Resolution. 33 34 35 36 OFFERED BY:
