HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THAT MALUHIA, IN CONCERT WITH LEAHI HOSPITAL, INITIATE MASTER PLANNING ACTIVITIES TO UPGRADE ITS FACILITIES AND COLLABORATE WITH OTHER LONG-TERM CARE PROVIDERS TO ADDRESS HAWAII'S INCREASING ELDERLY AND CHRONICALLY ILL POPULATIONS.

WHEREAS, the Maluhia facility, which was established in 1 2 1923 and provides long term-care inpatient services and services for the elderly, has a history of responding to Hawaii's elderly 3 and chronically ill populations; and 4 5 WHEREAS, there persists a lack of the availability of long-6 term care alternatives that are accessible, affordable, and 7 comprehensive; and 8 9 WHEREAS, along with Leahi Hospital, another Oahu regional 10 facility, Maluhia has embarked on revisiting its mission and 11 vision as a first step to updating its master plan; and 12 13 WHEREAS, both facilities continue to deal with and prepare 14 15 for the challenges of existing fiscal constraints and emerging, new payment schemes for long-term care institutions and 16 services; and 17 18 WHEREAS, Leahi Hospital is planning to undertake a master 19 planning effort for its campus; now, therefore, 20 21 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 22 23 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2008, that this body supports Maluhia's efforts to 24 work with Leahi Hospital to establish a coordinated master 25 planning effort to provide innovative long-term care services; 26 and 27 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that as a result of these master 29 planning efforts, the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation is 30 requested to pursue any needed resources during the Regular 31 Session of 2009; and 32
