HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO MAINTAIN A TEACHER'S STEP STANDING WHEN A TEACHER TRANSFERS BACK TO THE DOE FROM A CONVERSION CHARTER SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, teachers in the Department of Education (DOE) are 1 paid salaries according to step and class; and 2 3 WHEREAS, step is assigned based on an individual's years of 4 teaching experience prior to joining DOE, and whether or not the 5 teacher has completed a state-approved teacher education 6 program; and 7 8 WHEREAS, under current policy, teachers may lose their step 9 standing when a teacher transfers back to a DOE school from a 10 school that has converted to charter status, thereby subjecting 11 them to salary cuts and diminishing the record of experience 12 they have worked so hard for; and 13 14 WHEREAS, Kamaile Elementary School in Waianae has been 15 converted into a charter school and will lose approximately 22 16 teachers in the 2008-2009 school year because teachers are 17 either transferring to another school or simply quitting; now, 18 19 therefore, 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 21 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 22 Session of 2008, that DOE is urged to maintain a teacher's step 23 standing if a teacher transfers from a conversion charter school 24 back to a DOE school; and 25 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 27 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of 28 Education, Superintendent of Education, Executive Director of 29
