## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO INVESTIGATE AND DETERMINE THE ISSUE OF OWNERSHIP OF ULAINO ROAD IN MAUI.

WHEREAS, Ulaino Road is a four-mile gravel road in Maui 1 that runs from the Hana Highway junction to the Muliwai in 2 Ulaino; and 3 4 WHEREAS, although numerous homes are situated along Ulaino 5 Road, a jurisdictional dispute exists over the ownership of the 6 7 road; and 8 WHEREAS, despite a recent court decision that found the 9 roadway to be privately owned, the Legislature believes that a 10 legal opinion from the Attorney General would add more clarity 11 to this issue; and 12 13 WHEREAS, the matter of jurisdictional responsibility must 14 be resolved to provide necessary public services to residents 15 with homes on Ulaino Road and to avoid future threats to their 16 safety and well-being; now, therefore, 17 18 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 19 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 20 Session of 2008, that the Department of the Attorney General is 21 requested to investigate and determine the issue of ownership of 22 Ulaino Road; and 23 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of the Attorney General is requested to submit a report of any findings and 26 recommendations to the Legislature no later than twenty days 27 prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2009; and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 30 Resolution be transmitted to the Attorney General, the Director 31 of Transportation, the Chairperson of the Board of Land and 32
