## HOUSE RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING B.J. PENN THE CURRENT LIGHTWEIGHT ULTIMATE FIGHTING CHAMPION ON HIS SUCCESSFUL MARTIAL ARTS CAREER.

1 WHEREAS, the State of Hawaii, the premier sports capital of 2 the Pacific, is proud to recognize those select individuals who 3 manifest their God-given talents to exemplify sportsmanship, 4 grace, and goodwill to the people of the State and to the world; 5 and

WHEREAS, the Ultimate Fighting Championship (UFC) was 7 started in 1993 as a professional mixed martial arts (MMA) 8 organization offering the premier series of MMA sports events, 9 and in 2001, completely restructured MMA into a highly organized 10 and controlled combat sport with programs offered through cable 11 and satellite providers and distributed throughout the world, 12 including broadcasts on Viewer's Choice in Canada, MAIN EVENT in 13 Australia, Globosat in Brazil, and Setanta and Bravo in the 14 United Kingdom; and 15

WHEREAS, ultimate fighting is a proprietary term of the UFC and is defined as mixed martial arts competition between high level professional fighters who utilize the disciplines of jiujitsu, karate, boxing, kickboxing, wrestling, and other forms in UFC live events; and

WHEREAS, born in 1978 in Kailua, Oahu, and raised in Hilo, 23 Hawaii, B.J. PENN's mixed martial arts training began at the age 24 of 17 when his neighbor, Tom Callos, initiated him into the 25 technique of Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu, and subsequently introduced 26 him to Ralph Gracie, one of the great Brazilian martial artists 27 and scion of the internationally famous Gracie Family dynasty 28 that owns and operates martial arts academies across the United 29 States and internationally; and 30

WHEREAS, to further his jiu-jitsu training, B.J. PENN 1 relocated to Mountain View, California in 1997 and studied under 2 Ralph Gracie, completing the phenomenal achievement of earning 3 his black belt status in Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu in just three years 4 time, and in 2000, just days after earning his black belt, won a 5 gold medal at the Mundial World Championships held in Rio de 6 Janeiro, Brazil, for which he merited his nickname of "The 7 8 Prodigy"; and

WHEREAS, B.J. PENN's accomplishments, skills, and 10 determination caught the attention of the UFC where he launched 11 his MMA career in 2001 and quickly became the number one 12 lightweight contender leading up to his crowning achievement in 13 2004 at UFC 46 when he challenged the heavily favored five-time 14 defending UFC welterweight champion Matt Hughes and soundly won 15 the championship when he applied a Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu hold that 16 forced Hughes to submit and relinquish his title just four 17 minutes into the first round; and 18

WHEREAS, from 2004 to 2005, B.J. PENN left the UFC and entered to fight in the K-1 organization, an organization which combines stand-up techniques from Muay Thai, Karate, Taekwondo, Savate, San shou, Kickboxing, and traditional Boxing to determine the single best stand-up fighter in the world, where he competed in welterweight, light heavyweight, and middleweight levels, winning all but one of his matches; and

WHEREAS, in early 2006, B.J. PENN returned to the UFC as a top welterweight contender and rededicated himself to earning an opportunity to compete in the lightweight championship; and 31

WHEREAS, in a lightweight title bout with Joe Stevenson in January 2008, B.J. PENN defeated his opponent with a rear naked choke at 4:02 of the second round to win the UFC Lightweight Championship, making him the second man (after Randy Couture) to win UFC titles in two different weight classes; and

WHEREAS, over and above being a champion sportsman, B.J.
PENN is a perceptive businessman who emulates strong work ethics
modeled after parents JD Penn and Lorraine Shin, as he owns a
successful on-line store at BJPENN.COM that sells apparel,

books, DVDs, and headwear and offers non-stop martial arts 1 entertainment and instruction, and also operates an MMA academy 2 in Hilo with his brothers, Jay, Jaydee, Reagan, and Kalani; now, 3 4 therefore,
