SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A FOLLOW-UP FINANCIAL AUDIT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII JOHN A. BURNS SCHOOL OF MEDICINE AND ITS RELATED PARTIES, THE UNIVERSITY CLINICAL, EDUCATION, AND RESEARCH ASSOCIATES, INC. AND THE HAWAII RESIDENCY PROGRAM, INC.

WHEREAS, the Office of the Auditor conducted a financial 1 audit of the University of Hawaii John A. Burns School of 2 Medicine (School) for the fiscal year July 1, 2001 to June 30, 3 2002; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the audit examined the financial records and 6 7 transactions of the School, reviewed the related systems of accounting and internal controls, and tested transaction systems 8 and procedures for compliance with laws and regulations; and 9 10 WHEREAS, deficiencies were found in the internal control 11 practices of the School; and 12 13 WHEREAS, the School's administration and management of its 14 contracts with health care organizations that provide training 15 and medical services was found to be deficient; and 16 17 WHEREAS, among the deficiencies found were: 18 19 Contracts had been signed and executed subsequent to 20 (1)21 the contract date; 22 (2) Final reconciliations of the amounts due from health 23 care organizations were not completed in a timely 24 manner; and 25 26 (3) Non-compliance with the University's policies and 27 procedures regarding conflict of interest situations 28 involving School faculty occurred; and 29 30



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WHEREAS, the Auditor's report recommended that the School 1 revise the way it handles contract negotiations with health care 2 organizations, and commence services only after contracts are 3 finalized and executed; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the University Clinical, Education, and Research 6 Associates, Inc. (UCERA) is a separately incorporated not-for-7 8 profit corporation, which contributes to the School's goal of 9 improving the health care status of the citizens of Hawaii and the Pacific area by supporting the academic mission of the 10 School; and 11 12 WHEREAS, UCERA functions as a practice plan for the faculty 13 of the University of Hawaii John A. Burns School of Medicine, 14 providing a vehicle by which clinical revenues can be generated 15 16 on a limited scale during their non-university, private practice 17 time; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the Hawaii Residency Program, Inc. (HRP) is a separately incorporated not-for-profit corporation that 20 coordinates the administration of Hawaii's residency training 21 programs through a joint effort between the School and several 22 23 of Oahu's major hospitals and medical centers; and 24 WHEREAS, the financial information of UCERA and HRP was not 25 included in the 2003 financial audit of the University of Hawaii 26 27 John A. Burns School of Medicine that was conducted by the Office of the Auditor because the School and the University are 28 not financially accountable for these entities; and 29 30 WHEREAS, a follow-up audit of the University of Hawaii John 31 A. Burns School of Medicine should be conducted and include an 32 audit of the School's related parties, UCERA and HRP; and 33 34 35 WHEREAS, the Auditor is constitutionally and statutorily responsible for auditing state and county programs, 36 expenditures, and any agencies that receive state funds, and 37 undertakes audits at the request of the Legislature or upon the 38 39 Auditor's initiative; now, therefore, 40 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth 41 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2008, the 42 House of Representatives concurring, that the Auditor is 43 requested to conduct a financial audit of the University of 44



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Hawaii John A. Burns School of Medicine and its related parties, 1 the University Clinical, Education and Research Associates, Inc. 2 and the Hawaii Residency Program, Inc.; and 3 4 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to submit a report of any audit findings and recommendations, 6 including any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later 7 than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session 8 of 2009; and 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 11 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, the 12 President of the University of Hawaii, the University of Hawaii 13 14 Board of Regents, the Dean of the University of Hawaii John A.
